BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

Back in April, we welcomed **Sophia Hatfield** to the Museum. Sophia is our **Storyteller in Residence**, tasked
with bringing the history surrounding
the Brontës and the local area to life in
imaginative and creative ways – and we have
to say, she's very good at it!

For a whole day, Sophia set up camp in the Servant's Room, dressed in her "storytelling trousers", shirt, and braces, and armed with an eclectic selection of everyday items. Amongst other objects, she had a broom, a basket, a rug beater, and a couple of giant spools of thread. Using the items, she told wonderous stories to visitors of all ages as they stopped by the room.

But these weren't just any stories. For months, Sophia has been researching folk tales associated with the Yorkshire area – tales the Brontës' servant, Tabby, likely told the young siblings, captivating their minds and sparking a love of storytelling. Interwoven with beautiful singing, live accordion playing, and evocative strings on her violin, Sophia took our visitors on a journey to a Yorkshire we both know and don't know anymore.

This was a time when boggarts existed – tricksy creatures who love to help... as long as you don't get on their wrong side! Not-so-wicked witches, magical waterfalls, and vengeful fairies all played their part, and there were a few familiar characters who cropped up in Sophia's tales too – like Martha, the young girl the Brontës took on to help around the house.

Don't worry if you missed it though – the session received some wonderful feedback from visitors and we're looking forward to having Sophia back in the Museum in the



not-too-distant future...

In the meantime, Sophia's teamed up with theatre designer Rachel Shore to create an immersive audio storytelling installation, which you can listen to yearround in the Servant's Room. Like the day of live storytelling, this exhibition weaves traditional folk tales with everyday objects the young Brontës would have used – conjuring up mighty ship sails from old white shirts and deadly cutlasses from sewing needles. It's a reminder of how children can transform the mundane into the extraordinary – a skill we never really lose... it just needs dusting off every now and then.

While 700+ volunteers might sound like a lot, considering we had around 100 volunteers on duty during the Spring Gala of the Railway's operation. A more regular operating day requires a couple of dozen volunteers, but when we have seven steam locomotives hauling trains, a shuttle service between Ingrow and Keighley, an intensive timetable, and guided tours, it takes a much greater effort.

In addition to all the effort that went into the Gala weekend, we are getting started on our 2024 programme of dining trains. We will offer a selection of afternoon tea options, including a Yorkshire twist on a modern and more traditional offering. We also have the return of the Haworth Haddock fish and chip supper trains.

It's not just events that are taking our time this year. We are nearing the end of the project to open the Water Tower at



Risi e Bisi (Rice & Peas)



Fresh peas are now in season, another sign that spring is finally here. The price of peas comes down quite quickly as May progresses so you may want to wait till later in the month to try cooking this dish.

Fresh peas are best for this recipe but you can use frozen. If so, reduce the weight of peas to 500g.

Although the recipe uses risotto rice, it isn't a risotto as it doesn't need constantly stirring, it is much simpler.

I like to serve this dish with chicken thighs, slathered in olive oil and simply grilled with a small knob of butter, a few good grinds of salt and black pepper and a little bit of balsamic vinegar drizzled over each portion once on the plate.

Ingredients

50g unsalted butter

I small onion, peeled and finely chopped I kg of fresh peas, still in their pods Sea salt

I litre of chicken stock (or vegetable stock if preferred)

200g risotto rice

I bunch of flat leaf parsley, roughly chopped 75 g parmesan, grated

Freshly ground black pepper



Method

First, pod yer peas!

Place a wide, heavy based sauté pan with a well-fitting lid over a medium flame. Add the butter and chuck in the chopped onion. Gently fry for a few minutes, stirring frequently until softened but not coloured. Now tip in the peas with a couple of pinches of sea salt, stir then pour in half of the chicken stock. Bring everything up to a gentle simmer, pop the lid on and cook over a low heat for ten minutes.

Remove the lid, add your rice, chopped parsley and the remaining stock. Bring back to a slow simmer, stirring occasionally, pop the lid back on and cook over a low heat for fifteen minutes until the rice is nearly cooked.

Remove the lid, stir and continue to simmer until all the stock has been absorbed. Chuck in the cheese and ground black pepper, stir well and serve.































Spinal discs ~ easing the pressure

It seems so benign. All you did was bend forward to put on your shoes, pick up your toddler or grab a pan from a low cupboard in the kitchen and then...BANG! It's a common scenario: a seemingly innocuous movement results in excruciating lower back pain, leaving you immobilized and bewildered. The culprit? Likely a slipped disc in the lumbar spine, a condition often lurking beneath the surface until triggered by a mundane action.

Our spine comprises 23 discs, acting as cushions between vertebrae. These discs.


with their tough outer shell (annulus fibrosus) and inner jelly-like substance (nucleus pulposus), can withstand substantial pressure. However, certain activities or postures can escalate pressure within the discs, leading to strain



and irritation of the outer shell.

Repetitive strain, whether from heavy manual labor, poor sitting posture, or constant forward-leaning standing positions, can cause small tears in the outer shell over time. Eventually, these tears widen, culminating in a "tipping point" where the jelly-like substance protrudes outward, pressing against spinal nerves, including branches of the sciatic nerve—a condition known as an open fissure disc bulge.

When faced with this agonizing pain, the immediate response is to lie flat, take pain



relief, apply ice, and allow the body time to alleviate the pressure on the affected disc. This facilitates the retraction of the protruding disc matter away from the sciatic nerve.

Understanding the pressure dynamics within spinal discs is crucial. A pressure chart

illustrates how various postures affect disc pressure: normal standing posture registers at 100%, while forward-leaning standing or slumped sitting significantly elevates pressure (150% and 185%)

respectively). Adding load to poor postures exacerbates the issue, reaching pressures of 220% and 275% respectively. Consequently, lying flat becomes imperative after a disc bulge, as it drastically reduces disc pressure, aiding in the retraction of protruded disc matter.

For individuals with sedentary or laborintensive occupations, this chart underscores the importance of maintaining proper posture and lifting techniques to mitigate the risk of spinal disc damage.

Wyedean Weaving: Sixty years of manufacturing marked with regal flourish



Three generations of Haworth's military accourrement manufacturer Wyedean Weaving have celebrated 60 years in business.

The firm, which was formed in 1964 by husband and wife team David and Norma Wright, is Haworth's oldest employer and today produces over 10,000 uniform-based items annually including the King's Coronation Medal ribbon and most recently, the British Armed Forces' regimental flags. David is pictured here with his secretary – and one of the company's first employees – Margaret Whalley, who now lives in St Lucia and has a large family in the Worth Valley.





Last month, the Wright family, led by Managing Director Robin Wright, his wife Debra and daughters Susannah and Rosie, hosted a special event to celebrate six decades in business and showcase the team's latest intricate embroidery work on the 2nd Battalion Irish Guards Company Colours, which consist of the King's Colour to be used at this year's Trooping and their Regimental Colour.

In a special twist to the celebrations, Wyedean's team of three skilled embroiderers Aileen Henderson, Wendy Hatton and Susan Jones and long-serving project manager Melanie Kaye, were awarded with the King's Coronation Medal for the integral part they played in creating new ceremonial items for the Coronation.
