COUNTRY COOKING & FORAGING FOR FOOD

For the promotion of Health & Wellbeing by Cath Bromwich



Earlier this year I shared with you my simple gravy recipe, and with Christmas on the way I thought I would add my

solution for stuffing. I bake it spread out on a greased baking dish, with sausages on top. I don't get complaints! You can stuff the bird if you prefer, but don't pack it in. Like many traditional recipes, this is a good way of using up older bread. It is not an exact recipe, just a base for you to adapt

as you like. I far prefer it to packet stuffing, and people in my cooking groups love it – they are quite surprised at how good it can taste!

Cath Bromwich, a Silsden resident, is a cookery teacher and forager. Her livelihood includes foraging and cookery courses, such as cooking on a budget and outdoor foraging and cooking experiences. Cath's stuffing

Oven setting: 180°C or gas mark 4 Ingredients:

1 onion, chopped small2-3 tablespoons of oil

1 egg

4-6 slices of white bread salt and pepper



Instructions:

Add the oil to a pan, gently sweat the onion until soft, season well. Let the cooked onion cool a bit. Take the crusts off the bread, then make the slices into crumbs (tear them into small pieces, then pop them in a blender if you have one, but no problem if not).

Mix the bread crumbs into the onion and oil. Then add plenty of seasoning: salt, pepper and your choice of: herbs, a couple of pinches of nutmeg or the grated zest of a lemon (I sometimes use both lemon zest and herbs). You can also add a finely chopped apple. Mix, taste, adjust seasoning, add an egg, mix again. Put in a baking dish and cover with sausages (or loosely stuff your bird) and bake for 45-60 minutes, or until the sausages are well cooked. Alternatively, bake on its own until the top is crispy and golden. Make more if you need a larger quantity. If you are baking your bird unstuffed, then pop a sliced lemon inside and season the bird well.

Last month I made a journey down to Calais along with Martin and Luke who head up the charity Fresh Waters in Keighley. Martin had access to a van through the charity, and we spent a number of weeks collecting, raising money, and sorting donations of different

items including tents and sleeping bags to take to Calais.


Once we had stocked the van we made the 300 mile journey via the ferry. When we entered the camp it was instantly clear how great a need there is there, as there's approximately 7000 refugees camping in awful conditions. It is mostly young men in the camp from numerous different countries affected by war and poverty, however there was also a large women's section

in the camp, and a number of children too. We linked up with a local charity there called 'L'auberge Des Migrants International' and it was encouraging to see the volunteer work already going on there through the organisation, and people who had committed months of their time to help the refugees. However it was quite easy to feel overwhelmed by the scale of people

living on that wasteland. They estimate around 100 refugees are arriving every week, with no sign of them being allowed into the UK, or being given proper housing in France. None the less it was still encouraging to see the small but instant impact we had by providing the items we brought to the charity, and helping distribute coats to the refugees. It's opened my eyes to

the need, and I look forward to exploring what more we as a church and community can do to help our fellow human beings.

A massive thank you to all who contributed in the lead up to the trip. We were overwhelmed by the donations of items – we couldn't fit them all in the van! Martin is considering another trip to Calais and we are also exploring other ways of helping the refugees as some get placed in the Bradford area – so watch this space!


