BEHIND THE SCENES at the BRONTË PARSONAGE MUSEUM



Autumn is here and the watery sunlight filters through the remaining leaves on the trees. Haworth and the moors are evocative at this time of year, often bathed in an eery mist which adds to the atmospheric beauty of the Parsonage and cobbled Main Street. It is still an unsettling time for many, with restrictions in place and not knowing what is round the corner, but somehow the Parsonage offers hope and a message that 'this too will pass.' Whether this is because of all of that has taken place within its walls, or because the building and the collection will still be here after we have all gone, or because of all the millions of people who have walked its rooms since Museum opened in 1928, it's hard to say, but autumn in Haworth is a special time of year .

Over the summer, while we were physically closed to the public, we

launched The Brontë Lounge, a digital event space for readings, discussions and conversations about the Brontës. At one of these events, our guest, broadcaster Samira Ahmed, commented that lockdown had made her feel 'more like a Brontë': more reading, staying at home, carrying out more domestic activities, walking the local

area and exploring familiar surroundings with fresh eyes. I'm sure many of us have noticed how well-trodden local footpaths are or have decided to visit somewhere nearby that they have previously overlooked. Since we reopened in August, several visitors have told us they haven't visited the Museum since they came on a school trip or with a grandparent as a child. If that sounds like you, or you live nearby and have never visited, the quiet, atmospheric days of November and December are a perfect time to put that right. Just head to www.bronte.org.uk/visit-us to read all the information about the safety measures we have in place and how to book a ticket. Visitors will once again be able to visit East Riddlesden Hall this autumn. Starting from Saturday 14 November, the property will open on weekends only.

East Riddlesden Hall closed in March due to the coronavirus outbreak. Although some National Trust properties have already reopened, the size of East Riddlesden meant extra precautions had to be taken to ensure social distancing measures could be observed.

The house and gardens have many small entrances, so visitors are asked to wait patiently and observe social distancing. Inside the house, shop and café visitors will be asked to wear a mask and follow any one-way systems. Hand sanitiser will be available and toilet facilities will be cleaned more regularly.

Craig Best, West Yorkshire Operations Manager for the National Trust, said, "It was a really difficult decision not to reopen East Riddlesden Hall earlier as we know how important this property is to the local community."

In an era when cross-country running was very different to the sport we find these day, Ingrow Harriers was the area's best known club. Founded in September 1894, the club headquarters was initially at the Great Northern Inn, before a change twelve months later to the Heber Coffee House. Club colours were black vests with a gold sash. The club's annual handicap race was for the 'Licensed Victuallers Cup'. The club also organised two boxing competitions for its members in 1900, although it is clear that this was not intended to improve performance over the country. In March 1897, with E Ascough finishing 10th, the club finished fourth in the team event in the Iunior race at the Yorkshire Cross-Country Championships at Rotherham.

By 1897 the club was based at the Hope & Anchor Inn. Club colours were changed to black vests with white facings, with a white badge affixed to the left breast, and it was these colours that the club retained when they absorbed the Ingrow Parish Church Harriers in September 1898, with the base now being at the White Horse Inn. Ascough became one of the district's top runners, with the some fine, and consistent, performances in the Yorkshire CrossCountry Championships, with Ascough winning the Junior title in 1902 and 1904. He was also runner-up in 1898 and third in 1901 and , 4th in 1900 and 10th again in 1899, before going on to run for Halifax Harriers.

Ingrow Athletic Club Harriers was a separate club, formed in November 1896, with Sam Law, the licensee at the White Horse Inn, Ingrow, its President. It was not uncommon for the two Ingrow clubs to arrange training runs from the same base on the same day and it was no surprise when they joined forces on 25th August 1898 following a meeting at the White Horse. In those days, two hares would set off on a Saturday afternoon and leave a paper trail for fast and slow packs to follow, hence the sport's nickname of 'hare & hounds'.

Ingrow Harriers renamed itself as Keighley Harriers in 1903, changing its headquarters back to the Great Northern Inn, and adopting new club colours of red vests and black knickers. A new base on Woodhouse Road was being used by 1905, but by then the club was in decline and seems to have wound up at the end of that year.

his hearty casserole takes only 15 mins to prepare and then it cooks itself. Ideal if you're looking for something easy for dinner. Busy evening? You can leave this dish cooking and get on with other things. Plus, it's ready in just 4 easy steps, so you know this sausage stew is an easy recipe that you can make for a no-fuss midweek meal.

Ingredients

- I tbsp olive oil
- 8 thick sausages
- I onion, peeled and cut into slices
- 2 garlic cloves, peeled and finely chopped
- I leek, washed and cut into thick slices
- 2 medium potatoes, peeled and cut into
- chunks (approx 450g)
- 2tsp smoked paprika
- 2×400 g tins plum tomatoes
- Splash of red wine
- 200ml beef stock
- 350g cannellini beans (drained weight)
- Salt and pepper
- Small handful of flat-leaf parsley or chives,
- chopped
- Crusty bread, to serve

Method

Heat the oil in a large sauté pan and fry the sausages for 8-10 mins, turning frequently until browned all over. Remove from the pan, cut in half and set aside.

Drain any excess oil from the pan then add the onion and garlic and sauté for a few minutes to soften. Add in the leeks, potato and smoked paprika and cook for 4-5 mins.

Pour in the tomatoes, red wine and stock and bring to the boil. Reduce the heat and return the sausage pieces to the pan, along with the cannellini beans. Cover with a lid and cook for 20-25 mins over a low heat. stirring occasionally. Remove the lid and continue to cook for a further 5-10 mins.

Season to taste, and scatter with parsley or chives. Serve with crusty bread. Serves 4-6
