

In Thornton, Santa will be visiting the Christmas Tree Festival (25 November – 2 December), at St James' Church, where you'll also find a wonderful selection of decorated trees creating a magical display. at the Victorian Christmas Market at the Bradford Industrial Museum (25-26 November), along with a variety of stalls, roasted chestnuts, brass band and even an appearance from Scrooge, it will be a truly traditional way to start the Christmas season. For something completely different, pull on your trainers and sign up for the Haworth Santa Fun Run (3 December) for a unique race around the village.

Throughout November and into December festive lights will be switched on, with events across the Bradford district. The Festive Launch at The Broadway, Bradford (11 November) will be a full day of festivities including music, guest appearances and competitions. On 25 November, Shipley will be enjoying a day of free, family entertainment in the town before the lights are switched on, while in Ilklev there will be live music and entertainment on The Grove. In Keighley there will be live music and a performance by Gareth Gates before he switches on the town's lights on 26 November. The following week will see the light up weekend in Haworth on 2-3 December; Bingley will host an event with outdoor market, Santa's grotto, and DJ for the switch on (2 December), and in Baildon there will be live music and festive food and drink at various venues as they switch on the lights on 3 December.



The Railway is just drawing breath at the end of a very busy season, rounded off by the annual Beer and Music Festival, which was a we get to take a break now, but we now turn at the end of November, We've been asked since early January, and they've now been on sale for several weeks and we already have a number of dates with full trains, so please head to the website and book soon if you

Aside from events, work to maintain the Railway continues. It is an expensive and timeconsuming process, with our larger projects taking years of planning. One such is the operation because without it our loco fleet locomotives.' would be trapped in the yard at Haworth, and the main line would be severed between there and Oxenhope. It's a project that is projected to cost nearly £1.5m and we are very pleased to report that we have been successful in our application to the government's 'Community Ownership Fund', and have been awarded a £1m grant to help with the immense cost of the project. We are very grateful, not least because it means that we continue to invest in locomotive overhauls, with each of thousands of pounds, as well as the many other infrastructure projects that we had put services and events. on hold pending the completion of the bridge replacement.

There are other developments across the Railway, most noticeably at Keighley, where work to refurbish the inside of the water sell-out event on Saturday. I'd like to say that tower building is underway, into which we hope to welcome passengers next year, our attention to readying for you-know-what opening a space that has hitherto been closed to visitors. We are grateful for funding about tickets for our Elf Explorer services from the Railway Heritage Trust and Keighley Town Deal to support the development of the water tower building. Developments continue elsewhere too, as we finalise plans for improvements to the volunteer plan to join us for a special Christmas journey. accommodation and tour groups facilities at Haworth, and - again - this work is partly funded by a contribution from the Town Deal. If that wasn't enough, we are preparing ourselves for a busy programme of events for 2024 and continuing to restore and replacement of a bridge vital to the Railway's maintain our fleet of historic carriages and






Behind the scenes at the Museum

From the collection

As the frost settles in for the winter, we highlight an item from the collection that served a useful practical purpose for Patrick Brontë in the harsher months, and the friend who gave it to him.

In 1854 Patrick Brontë was gifted a pair of
