This easy recipe is a healthy alternative to cauliflower cheese and adds interest to any meal as a side dish. You

can spice it up by substituting the olive oil with chili oil, or turn up the citris vibe with lemon oil. The beauty of cauliflower is its ability to carry seasonings and the roasting further

intensifies flavours.

Enjoy!

Ingredients

- I small head cauliflower
- I 1/2 teaspoons fennel seeds
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons smoked paprika
- I 1/4 teaspoons sea salt
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1/2 lemon, juiced

Optional Garnish: sesame seeds and parsley

Method

Step | Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).

Step 2

Trim large leaves off cauliflower. Trim stalk so cauliflower can sit flat in a Dutch oven.

Step 3

Grind fennel seeds with a mortar and pestle. Mix in smoked paprika, salt, pepper, and garlic powder. Whisk in olive oil to form a paste. Rub the paste all over the cauliflower. Drizzle lemon juice all over.

Step 4

Bake in the preheated oven, covered, until tender, about 35 minutes. Uncover and baste with any juices that have pooled at the base. Continue baking, uncovered, until top is browned and center feels completely tender when pierced with a paring knife, about 20 minutes. Garnish and serve.



Focus on: **Osteoporosis** by David Hanson, Haworth Physio

Osteoporosis is a health condition that weakens bones, making them fragile and more likely to break. It develops slowly over many years and is often only diagnosed when a fall or sudden impact causes a bone to fracture.

The most common injuries in people with osteoporosis are:

• broken wrist • broken hip • broken spinal bones (vertebrae)

Osteoporosis is not usually painful until a bone is broken, but broken bones in the spine are a common cause of long-term pain.

Who's affected by osteoporosis?

Osteoporosis affects over 3 million people in the UK. More than 500,000 people receive hospital treatment for fragility fractures (bones that break after falling from standing height or less) every year as a result of osteoporosis.

Causes of osteoporosis

Losing bone density is a normal part of ageing, but some people lose bone much faster than normal. This can lead to osteoporosis and an increased risk of broken bones.

Women also lose bone rapidly in the first few years after the menopause. Women are more at risk of osteoporosis than men, particularly if the menopause begins early (before the age of 45) or they have had their ovaries removed.

However, osteoporosis can affect men, younger women and children.

Many other factors can also increase the risk of developing osteoporosis, including: • taking high-dose steroid tablets for more than 3 months

a family history of osteoporosis particularly a hip fracture in a parent
long-term use of certain medicines that can affect bone strength or hormone levels, such as anti-oestrogen tablets that many women take after breast cancer



Normal Osteoporosis

• having or having had an eating disorder such as anorexia or bulimia

not taking regular exercise

• heavy drinking and smoking.

Preventing osteoporosis

If you're at risk of developing osteoporosis, you should take steps to help keep your bones healthy. This may include:

• taking regular exercise to keep your bones as strong as possible. Weightbearing exercise and resistance exercise are particularly important at improving bone density and helping to prevent osteoporosis.

• eating healthy - including foods rich in calcium and vitamin D

• taking a daily supplement containing 10 micrograms of vitamin D

• making **lifestyle changes** - such as giving up smoking and reducing your alcohol consumption.

Weight bearing exercises are exercises where your feet and legs support your weight.

High-impact weight-bearing exercises, such as running, skipping, dancing and aerobics are all useful ways to strengthen your muscles, ligaments and joints and to maintain and improve bone density. Swimming and cycling therefore DO NOT come into this category. When possible, get some sun! Moderate levels of unprotected sun exposure can be healthy and very helpful in boosting vitamin D.




