





Our local hospital is in desperate need of a rebuild

Keighley and Ilkley MP Robbie Moore updates readers on his campaign for a new **Airedale Hospital**



Home to a fantastic team of doctors, nurses and NHS staff, the heroes at Airedale Hospital consistently go above and beyond to serve our area. But if there is one thing that we have known for a long, long time, it's that the original hospital building — which was built in the late 1960s with a planned life expectancy of 30 years - is falling apart.

That is why when I was elected as the Member of Parliament for Keighley and Ilkley, I launched my campaign for a full rebuild of Airedale Hospital and to date have lobbied the government on this campaign more than anything else. Whether that was holding a personal debate on Airedale Hospital in Parliament, lobbying the Prime Minister at PMQs and in separate forums, or holding meetings with the Department of Health and Social Care, I have made it clear to every level of government that sticking plaster solutions for our brilliant local hospital simply will not do.



I want readers to know that my campaign is making progress.

After visiting Airedale Hospital twice more in February to hear from the Airedale NHS Foundation Trust about how a rebuild could drastically improve the quality of health services in our area, I held a trio of meetings with the Prime Minister, our Secretary of State for Health and Social Care and the Minister in charge of Hospital Rebuilding.

In March, I met with the Chancellor to make economic case for a new hospital, with a further meeting with the Prime Minister soon to come.

During these meetings, I make sure the government hears about what we here in Keighley, Ilkley, Silsden, the Worth Valley know far too well: Our hospital was built with a planned life expectancy of 30 years. It has now been over 50 years. Our hospital is constructed from over 83% aerated concrete – a material known for

its dangerous structural defects. Our hospital has over 50,000 aerated concrete panels running through its walls, floors, and roof – that's five times more than any other hospital in the UK. Whilst I recognise that it is a huge sum of funds I am lobbying for, a full rebuild

of funds I am lobbying for, a full rebuild of Airedale Hospital is about the future of health care provision in our area for generations to come.

And so, as your MP, I will not stop lobbying the government at every level to deliver on this campaign.


We're There For You





Covid Secure





Apart from being one of my favourite things to cook, eat and serve to guests, this is also one of the cheapest Sunday dinners you can cook; you should be able to buy a 2kg "corner" gammon joint for about £12-£13 which will feed 6 people very well with leftovers for a good soup too. You'll definitely save money by going to a proper butcher rather than a supermarket here.

Ingredients

2kg "corner" gammon joint

2 large carrots

I large leek

I large onion

8 cloves, salt, nutmeg

2 dozen or so black peppercorn

300ml milk

I small onion

50g butter

50g plain flour

100ml double cream

900g bag of frozen chopped spinach

Method

Get the biggest stovetop pot you've got, put the gammon in it, fill with cold water and bring to the boil. Whilst you're waiting, roughly chop the carrots, leek and celery, peel the large onion and stud with 6 of your cloves.

When the pot boils, drain, rinse the gammon joint, and return the gammon to the pot with the carrots, leek, celery and onion / cloves and

peppercorns, cover with water again and bring back up to a very gentle simmer. Let the joint simmer gently for 2-2 ½ hours. Test it's done by pushing a skewer right through it. If it is done, this should require little effort.

Meanwhile, put the frozen spinach in a pan, cover with water, bring to the boil and drain the spinach into a large sieve to drain then transfer into a bowl and set aside.

Now put the milk in a pan, together with the peeled and chopped small onion, 2 cloves and a pinch of salt, bring to the boil then put to one side to infuse for several minutes.

Wash & dry the pan you boiled your spinach in and melt the butter over a low heat, once melted, add your flour, and stir gently for a minute or two. Remove from the heat, strain the milk into the pan, whisk thoroughly then return to the heat, stirring until thickened. Cook over a very low heat for five minutes or so before adding the spinach, cream, nutmeg and ground black pepper, stir to mix, and keep warm over a low heat.

Take three or four ladles of the broth from the ham pot and put into a small pan, boil vigorously over a high heat until reduced in volume by a third.

Slice and serve the ham with the creamed spinach, and some boiled and buttered potatoes and carrots, drizzle a couple of spoonsful of the reduced broth over the sliced ham. A bit of English mustard on the side is good too in my opinion.

If you want to make a really good soup the following day, drain and reserve the remaining broth, let it cool to room temperature then cover and refrigerate.

To make the soup, bring the broth back to a simmer and add about 300 / 400 g of red lentils, any remaining shredded ham. If you have any boiled potatoes left over, dice them and chuck them in yer pot. Add a couple of teaspoons of mild curry powder. Simmer gently for 30 minutes until the lentils are cooked. You can adjust the thickness of the soup to your taste by simmering longer to thicken, or by adding water to make more "soupy". I like to add some shredded white cabbage and cooking for another 5-10 minutes, then you've got yourself a second meal which is really good served with crusty bread, butter and some cheese.


