'BACK IN STEAM' SUMMER SPECIALS



It's been 52 years since the railway was saved and brought back to life by a group of dedicated, local volunteers. Today, our volunteers have shown true grit and determination again and have helped to pull the railway through a very difficult few months. With thanks to them and the generous support of everyone who has donated to our fundraising campaign, we'll soon be bringing back the steam.

As part of a phased re-opening, our 'Back in Steam Summer Specials' will be running on selected days from 19th August.

Return journeys will depart from Oxenhope, and will include a 20 minute break at Keighley where passengers can stretch their legs. Back at Oxenhope there'll be an opportunity to pose for photographs next to the engine.

We'll be using private compartments which seat one to eight passengers, and on Sundays we'll be running Vintage Train Sundays using vintage and First Class stock that's rarely used on the Railway.

Passengers have no contact with fellow passengers or staff in these compartments so face coverings aren't compulsory during the journey.

The Oxenhope Exhibition Shed has been transformed to a spacious waiting room where more engines can be seen up close. Here there'll also be a pop-up shop and café.

From 19th - 30th August, trains will run on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturday and Sundays. We'll also be running on Bank Holiday Monday (31st August). All trains will depart from Oxenhope at 10.00 12.00 14.00 and 16.00

We understand that times may be hard at the moment, and so have priced our tickets depending on how many people are travelling in the same compartment. Passengers sharing a compartment must be part of a household or linked household.

This is one of my favourite recipes. Boikos are little cheese pastries from the Balkans and they are not only delicious, they are easy to make using only minimal equipment and effort. In fact, the less you do when you make them, the better they turn out. Just keep the ingredients cold and it will work perfectly.

Ingredients

100g plain flour 100g cold butter cut into small dice 100ml sour cream 4 spring onions finel chopped 80g crumbled feta 80g grated mature cheddar 2 tsp nigella seeds Good pinch of salt Milk to glaze

Method

Pre heat oven to 220c/200c Fan/gas mark 7 Reserve I tsp of nigella seeds for garnish and then place all the ingredients in a large bowl. Use your hands to bring everything together until just combined. Lumps of butter and cheese in the mixture is what you want in this dough, when it bakes it will be oozy and delicious!

Place the dough onto a lightly floured work surface and then pat down or roll out to about 2/3cm thick. Using a small glass or biscuit cutter approx. 60mm diameter, cut out the Boikos and place on a baking sheet lined with parchment, repeat onto another tray as necessary. Scrunch the leftovers back together and repeat to use all the mix up.

Brush each boikos with the milk and then scatter with a few of the reserved nigella seeds.

Bake for ten minutes and then carefully turn the trays round, reduce the oven to 200c/180c fan/gas mark 6 and bake for a further 6/8 minutes until golden. Cool slightly and then devour!

August 2020 LONG LIVE SUMMER! by Lee Senior

Incredibly we are already approaching the final few weeks of summer. How on earth did that happen? In this year of ongoing turmoil it is rather a shame that summer cannot somehow be extended! Sustainable perennial planting schemes are generally my preference in gardens.

However, I have to say this year, the extra flower power of summer bedding plant displays has been a boost for everyone. Sunflowers are giving their best now and make a fine spectacle for children and adults

alike. Small birds such as chaffinches love to eat the seeds after flowering too.

If we have another long dry spell, one tip is to raise the mower blades or cut the grass a little frequently. This allows the grass to grow a little longer and stay greener. It will also cope better with drought.

The veg garden is still awash with fresh and tasty vegetables. Runner beans should be harvested regularly, before the beans become too stringy. Turnips are less woody and more tender when harvested small at golf ball size.

It is good practice to regularly pick most herbs routinely. This delays the flowering of the plants and stops them becoming leggy. Parsley is perfect for sowing now with a view to cropping indoors over winter. Seed germination is slow, taking up to five weeks. Grow the plants on, two per 4inch (10cm) pot.

One thing to keep an eye on now is for an outbreak of those familiar cabbage white butterfly caterpillars on our brassica plants. The foliage can be destroyed in less than twenty four hours during bad attacks. Check regularly for any clusters of green eggs both on the tops of the leaves and underneath them.These can be spotted on the host plant and destroyed before they hatch. I use the finger and thumb method



to control small amounts though admittedly it is not one for the squeamish. Using fine netting over the top of the beds resting on hoops or supports remains the best organic control. Prevention as ever is better than cure. Whitefly and aphids are

also a prevalent pest. Again removing them by hand is a viable option in small spaces. If you resist using the chemical spray gun, ladybirds and larvae of hoverfly and lacewings can do a fine job mopping up these pesky pests.

After cropping has finished, our strawberry plants will produce young plants on runners. It is easy to use these to create a pot or strawberry barrel full of new plants for free. Simply peg down these young plants in a small pot of compost and detach them from the parent plant when they have rooted. Strawberry plants need replacing every three years to maintain worthwhile a harvest.
