impossible. If you lose mental capacity without an LPA, it can cost your family time and thousands of pounds to be given permission to handle your affairs. Without an LPA, any joint bank accounts you hold with your partner could become severely restricted. This can be devastating, especially if the joint owner has their income or pension paid into this account, or they use it to pay critical bills such as a mortgage or utility costs.

What is a Living Trust?



Golden Autumnal Hues by Lee Senior

Autumn arrives in our gardens this month and with it comes one of nature's finest displays. Very little in nature can beat this grand finale of stunning, fiery leaf colour just before the trees shed their foliage for winter.

The fallen, spent leaves are great for making leaf mould too. This very useful soil improver is created by simply gathering fallen deciduous leaves and leaving them for a year to rot down. They can be put in bags or simply left out in the open. Don't be tempted to add the leaves to a compost bin as they rot down much slower than normal

garden material. The so-called dormant period between now a

period between now and the end of March is the ideal time to plant barerooted trees or fruit bushes. The advantage of trees in containers is they can be planted all year round. If you are ordering by mail

order it is important to unpack the trees straight away as they will have very little fibrous root. Give them a good soak before planting them in their final positions. Overwintered Onion sets and garlic can be planted this month. Garlic enjoys rather cold winter weather and the longer growing season given by Autumn planting. October and November are the busiest months of the year for bulb planting. No matter what the size of your garden there is a vast choice of both dwarf and larger daffodil varieties. Dwarf types will even grow in a deep window box, along with a smattering of crocus and snowdrops.

Indoors, specially prepared or 'forced' hyacinth bulbs can be planted now in a bowl for flowering in December. The heady scents of these fine bulbs are sure to brighten any room during the darker months.

The 'forced' bulbs have been heat treated to flower earlier than garden hyacinths which flower outdoors in April. To get a good root system it is a good idea to let the bulbs spend the first couple of weeks in the dark. Once roots form, they need a cool, well- light room or a frost-free unheated greenhouse. After

flowering the bulbs can be planted out in the garden and should flower outdoors in future years.
Finally, why not plant out a few winter bedding plants in key areas. Favourites such as polyanthus, primroses and

winter flowering pansies will not fail to disappoint. They will flower throughout the milder spells of winter and early next spring. Something we can all look forward to!



Riddlesden Rugby League

Rugby's great split of 1895 saw many professional Yorkshire and Lancashire teams break away from the Rugby Union and form their own competition, the Northern Union - which is now known as Rugby League.

The professional Keighley club didn't make

the switch until 1900. However. several local teams had already done so, one year earlier, and these teams included the long. gone Riddlesden club.

Formed prior to 1895-96 season. Riddlesden joined the Bradford-based Horton & District

League for the 1896-97 season, and played in the Keighley League the following season,

followed by a two season spell. in the Bradford & District League between 1898-1900, the second season in which they, along with the rest of the league, moved en-masse to the Northern Union.With the top teams in the

county having done so due to a power struggle with the Rugby Union which was based in London (which included payments for broken-time), the smaller, junior clubs

such as Riddlesden felt that they had little choice but to make that jump as well, in order not to miss out on possible prestigious fixtures against higher class teams. However, such benefits never came Riddlesden's way as the club did not survive

beyond 1900, folding due a lack of players. A new, reformed club appeared for the 1948-49 season, playing on the fields which are now part of the St.Marys school site at the end of Grange Road. The team play its fixtures in the

Bradford / Keighley League between 1948-53, and from 1953-55 in an independent


> Keighley & District League before once again folding up. Riddlesden's one major success came in the Keighley Cup final during the 1950-51 season, when Keighley Albion were defeated 9-7 in a tight

final. One year later, Riddlesden won through to their second successive final at Lawkholme Lane, but went down 25-6 to Silsden in the deciding tie. ~ Rob Grillo

WELCOME BACK TO THE BRONTË PARSONAGE MUSEUM

We were delighted to throw open the doors of the Parsonage once more on Friday 28 August and welcome back our first visitors. Being able to do so was the result of weeks of intensive work: poring over Government guidelines and risk assessments; commissioning and installing protective screens, hand sanitising stations and new signage; implementing online booking and timed ticketing and then sharing all of this with our staff and volunteers through a series of training days.

So what can you expect when you visit? Some things have changed, but other things, such as a warm welcome and informative and inspiring displays, haven't.

The biggest change is that admission is now by pre-booked timed ticket only – even for those who live nearby!

Those of you familiar with the Museum will know that it is an intimate, historic

building with our collections displayed in a number of small rooms. It's therefore very important that we control numbers and facilitate social distancing. Our online booking system also supports the NHS Test and Trace service by collecting the names and details of visitors.

Booking is via the Visit Us page of our website. You will be directed to Art Tickets and will be asked to select a date and time and type of ticket. If you still have a Aire Valley Mag 'Let me in, I'm local!' voucher to redeem,

you will find these in the Free and Promotional Tickets list. Your ticket is then emailed to you and you can print it out before your visit or download it to a mobile device.

Our staff are all wearing visors or facemasks and visitors are also required to wear face coverings. We have set up a one-way route through the museum and surfaces are cleaned at regular intervals during the day.

Museum is and screens have been installed at the cash desk and in the shop. Contactless payments are preferred, but we will accept cash where this is not possible.

Sarah Goodenough was one of our first visitors of our reopening weekend and shared this with us:

"It was so good to be back at the Museum. I felt very welcomed and safe and the museum staff did a wonderful

job of making me feel at ease. I felt like I had the Parsonage to myself due to the small groups allowed in at allocated times. Thank you to everyone involved for making the experience truly great despite such difficult times."

So whether you have been many times or have never quite got round to visiting the jewel on your doorstep, we hope Sarah's words will inspire you to come and see us when the time is right for you. We look forward to giving you a warm, but safe welcome. ~ Rebecca Yorke, Brontë Parsonage

Whilst we are thinking about Christmas, we continue to maintain the Railway and the fleet, and it was great to see the steam crane in operation in Haworth Yard earlier in




