



This is one of the tastiest but cheap and easy recipes I will ever write! ~ Enjoy

#### **Ingredients**

I tablespoon of olive oil Ikg chicken thighs (bone in & skin on, not filleted or skinned)

6 red bell peppers (orange or yellow will also do but definitely not green ones!) Salt & Black pepper

#### Method

You need a large, preferably wide, shallow and heavy stove top pot with a well fitting lid for this recipe.

Put your pot on a medium heat on the stove and pour in your oil.

When warm, chuck in your chicken thighs. Whilst the chicken is starting to cook, de-seed and cut your peppers into rough chunks. Stir and turn the chicken occasionally to prevent it sticking whilst preparing the peppers.

Add the peppers, stir occasionally for 5-10 minutes, turn the heat down to low and pop on the lid.

Cook for 40 minutes or so until the chicken is cooked and tender. Your pot should have loads of gravy from the peppers.

Season well with salt and pepper. I like to serve this with green beans or broccoli and either rice or bread to mop ~ Martin Lingard up the gravy.





## BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

'The Wild Hauntings on the Moor:
A Dream of Death' is an atmospheric new audio drama set on Penistone Hill, created by Obscura Theatre and cocommissioned by the Brontë Parsonage Museum and Ilkley Literature Festival. The team who created the piece tell us more about the inspiration they found in Haworth: At Obscura Theatre, whenever we embark

on a new project in a new place, we always like to begin with a visitation. Before any ideas take hold in our heads, before we put pen to paper we go and have a good old wander of wherever it is we will be inhabiting creatively. Getting out of the car on a chilly morning in West Yorkshire last October was the first time we had been to Haworth. We felt as though we were being dared by Catherine Earnshaw to "brave the ghosts".

We are fascinated by local

stories and we have been elated to find that Haworth and the surrounding moors have more than their fair share of tall tales to be uncovered. We spoke with professors and walking groups, bloggers and storytellers, and of course the fantastic folk at the Brontë Parsonage Museum. We even found some period costumes that the Museum lent us for

an impromptu photoshoot. We photographed Beth, our director, striding across the moor as if in search of doomed romance or a sense of belonging (our process is serious business, I assure you). And, once we were suitably in need of sustenance from all our striding, we stopped at Cobbles and Clay for a cuppa and a hearty bowl of 'Pasta Brontë'. We couldn't ask for a better stage and setting for our piece than the vast stretch of beautiful melancholy that is the landscape surrounding Haworth. We hope to transport listeners into the Haworth of the past,


encouraging them to walk with ghosts and see the land in a new light.




