Sharing Platters with a Mutabal Dip

If you have quite a few guests over for a festive gathering, you may struggle to think of a starter that everyone likes. I solve this by putting together sharing platters that people can graze on before the big meal, helping themselves to as little or as much as they like. This way, I can cater for vegans, vegetarians, pescatarians, carnivores, allergies and faddy so and so's!

I like to support local independent traders so tend to buy ingredients from businesses such as Haworth Wholefoods and Pavé on Haworth Main Street.

The trick is to serve a selection of meat, cheese, preserved fish and vegetables like peppers, artichokes, olives and capers that will provide a mix of flavours, colours and textures, plus dips, fresh fruit and vegetables and flatbreads, crackers or breadsticks. The selection I offer here includes Manchego, Comte, Kirkhams Lancashire, a small crottin goats' cheese, sliced mortadella, prosciutto, coppa and salami plus some caper berries; all from Pavé. Personally, I avoid runny, smelly, or blue cheeses as a starter, saving those for after dinner!

I supplemented this with tinned baby octopus, anchovies and smoked sardines preserved in olive oil (admittedly not to everyone's taste but I like them), a tin of Perello brand Gordal olives, some jars of artichokes and peppers preserved in oil and my favourite rosemary torta biscuits, all from Haworth Wholefoods.

You can supplement this spread with carrot sticks,

grapes, radishes, celery sticks and rocket leaves. I always provide dips too, such as hummus, baba ghanoush or taramasalata which can all be bought pre made from most supermarkets. I made a simple Mutabal dip, which is similar to baba ghanoush, but with tahini added; here is the recipe: Ingredients

- I large or 2 medium aubergines
- 2 tablespoons of tahini
- I medium to small red onion, finely chopped
- I tablespoon of lemon juice
- 4 fat cloves of garlic, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons of Greek yoghurt 2 tablespoons of extra virgin olive oil 1 teaspoon of sea salt flakes

Method

Preheat your oven to 200C, when up to temperature, pierce the skin of your aubergine(s) with a small sharp knife several times, place on a baking tray and stick in the oven for 45 minutes or so, until the aubergines are very soft when pierced with a knife or skewer. The skin should be darkened and burnt in places. Remove from the oven and set aside to cool.

When cool enough to handle safely, slice off the stalk end, peel the skin and bin it, then place the remaining softened flesh into a large bowl. Chuck all your other ingredients into the bowl. Use a hand blender to process until it has a smooth, creamy consistency, transfer into a serving bowl and pour over a little more olive oil and serve. Happy Christmas everyone! ~ Martin

Shoulder Pain and the Rotator Cuff

The shoulder joint, also known as the glenohumeral joint, is a joint prone to injury and pain. It is a ball and sockettype synovial joint and the most mobile joint in the human body. Unfortunately, this increased mobility results in poorer stability which makes this joint the most dislocated one!

The shoulder joint is one of the most complicated joints in the body and damage to this area can significantly affect your function and cause constant pain and distress. It comprises of the head of the humerus (the ball), the glenoid cavity of the shoulder girdle (the socket), a ring of cartilage called the labrum that helps to deepen the shallow socket and therefore increases the stability of the ball and socket, 30 different muscles, multiple ligaments and tendons, fluid-filled bursae and a network of nerves and blood vessels. The four rotator cuff muscles are the subscapularis, the supraspinatus, the infraspinatus and the teres minor. These four muscles arise from the scapula and insert via there tendon onto the head of the humerus.

The main function of the rotator cuff is to stabilise and centre the humeral head in the joint socket, the glenoid cavity. This action is known as concavity compression. A rotator cuff injury can cause a dull ache in the shoulder that worsens at night or when the arm is at rest. It may be difficult to get to sleep or you may wake up in pain if you roll onto your affected shoulder. There may also be difficulty, pain and weakness when raising, lowering or rotating your arm.

Rotator cuff injuries are common. They can occur after a traumatic event such as a shoulder dislocation or from years of repetitive movements which lead to 'wear and tear' of the tendons leading to inflammation and impingement. These 'wear and tear' injuries may occur earlier in people who have jobs that require repeatedly performing overhead actions, such as decorators and plasterers and in those who participate in sports such as swimming, tennis and weight lifting.

Rehabilitation of 'wear and tear' rotator cuff injuries will rarely involve surgery in the first instance. Shoulder rehabilitation exercises should begin in the early stages with mobility exercises, and progress to isometric or static strength exercises before dynamic exercises are introduced. The final stage of shoulder rehabilitation should involve functional or sports-specific exercises. Progress can be slow and patience is often required before a good outcome is achieved.

Recognise the signs that you have a rotator cuff injury and seek help from a medical professional if you are struggling to manage your pain or finding it difficult to function at work or with leisure activities.

BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

If you've visited the Brontë Parsonage Museum in recent weeks, you may have noticed some unusual activity taking place in the Exhibition Room. One of the larger items on display has undergone several weeks of restoration under the expert care of conservator David Everingham, and his colleague Alison Aynesworth (pictured). Visitors have been able to watch David and Alison in action as they carefully restore a

large cupboard linked to 'Jane Eyre', known as the 'Apostles' Cupboard' owing to its housing 12 individual paintings of the Apostles, over the last few weeks. It's been great to have David and Alison on-site to answer visitors' questions, generously sharing insight on the paintings, the process

and what exciting discoveries have been revealed.

David and Alison work with a method called 'unpacking' which involves carefully removing unwanted layers from a painting, revealing the original work unencumbered. The first layer to be removed typically comprises a thick coat of grime and dirt built up over time. This is removed using a water-based solution and sensitive cleaning tools. The second layer to be removed is a yellow varnish, which would have been applied long after the paintings, and the cupboard, were originally completed. This was presumably to protect the cupboard as an item of furniture, as opposed to the paintings themselves. The only way to remove the varnish is with a solvent which. David tells us, is the really nervy bit!

The conservators' knowledge of paints, solvents, and how they behave together, means they were able to remove this layer without damaging the paint beneath, and the results truly are astonishing. The process has revealed vivid colours and details in the panels that were previously hidden to the naked eye, such as lettering revealing the names of the Apostles depicted in the paintings. Work

is now underway to piece together the clues this work has revealed, hopefully bring to light more of the story behind this popular item. But what connects the cupboard with 'Jane Eyre'? Before it was acquired by the Museum, the cupboard belonged to Thomas Eyre of Hathersage in

Derbyshire. It is thought that Charlotte Brontë saw this cupboard when visiting Mr. Eyre in 1845, a year before writing the novel. Not only is there an obvious link in the 'Eyre' name, but Charlotte also graphically describes the cupboard in a scene in the novel, when lane is attending to wounds inflicted on Richard Mason! If you find yourself with an hour to spare over the festive period, do come and see the cupboard in its renewed glory, perhaps with the image from 'Jane Eyre' in mind... Local to the Museum? Residents living in BD20, BD21 and BD22 are eligible for a Local Resident admission rate of £7.50 with proof of address. Tickets are valid for 12 months after issue, meaning you can continue to return and enjoy the Museum as exhibits change throughout the year. **bronte.org.uk**
