

SUMMER at the BRONTË PARSONAGE MUSEUM

I'm writing this following three very busy weeks which saw the Parsonage lawn transformed into a war-time kitchen garden and our hallway and stairs given a full 1940s makeover while the Museum was a location for the forthcoming feature film, 'The Railway Children Return.' There was never a dull moment with the cast and crew around and it was a strange sight to see the Parsonage floodlit for night shoots and dozens of people scurrying about. While hard work, it was great fun to be part of

and we're sure the film will be a great advert for the Museum and Haworth when it and the new 'Emily' film are released next spring.

Behind the scenes, we've also been working hard on a national campaign to save unique and important manuscripts including a

notebook containing 31 poems by Emily Brontë and several 'little books.' The Honresfield Library, as the collection is referred to, only recently came to light after being unheard of for more than 80 years, and all 500 items of it were due to be sold off by auction. Thankfully, by working with colleagues at other literary houses and funding bodies, the auction has been postponed and we are now working on a collective fundraising campaign led by the Friends of the National Libraries to secure the required funds (expected to be around \pounds [5m!) to save it for the nation. As restrictions continue to ease, we're really pleased that our staff have returned

to work and there is some semblance of 'normality', whatever that is. Visitors have loved being back at the Museum, and while the restrictions on numbers continue to have an impact on our finances, it is wonderful to be able to share our special building and the collections it houses with people again. If you are visiting, be sure not to miss 'Gondal Arise!', our exhibition of illustrations of the Brontës' imaginary worlds by Isabel Greenberg, or our special installation, 'Contemplating Hope' by artist

Layla Khoo. We're also gearing up for our 10th Brontë Festival of Women's Writing which will run online Thursday 29 July – Sunday I August. We're thrilled to present events with LipService, Hollie McNish and Samira Ahmed, and there will also be writing workshops and

other opportunities to get creative yourself. Finally, we are really excited to be part of Bradford Council's 'Summer Unlocked' programme. 'Another World', our speciallycommissioned interactive installation will be situated in Parson's Field in August and you're all invited to come and explore and play.

Marsh Top Farm Shop Goat Curry

ingredients

- 700g diced Marsh Top Farm Shop goat or mutton
- 1 large onion, roughly chopped
- 10 garlic cloves
- 100g ginger, chopped
- 100ml vegetable oil
- Small handful curry leaves
- 4 tbsp mild curry powder
- Can chopped tomato
- 300ml lamb or beef stock
- Can of kidney or black-eyed beans
- Juice ½ lemon
- Small bunch coriander, chopped
- Serve with boiled rice and/or naan bread

instructions

- Place the onion, garlic and ginger in a food processor and blend to a purée. Heat the oil in
 a large flameproof casserole dish, add the onion mixture and cook for 5 mins until softened.
 Add the curry leaves, curry powder and 2 tsp salt. Cook for 2–3 mins until fragrant.
- Tip the mutton or goat into the pan. Cook for 5 mins over a medium-high heat until the meat has browned. Add the chopped tomatoes and stock. Increase the heat, bring to the boil and cook for 10 mins. Reduce heat, cover and leave to simmer gently for 2½ hrs – remove the lid for the final 30 mins of cooking.
- Add the beans to heat through. After 5 mins more, remove from the heat. Add the lemon juice and coriander, and stir well. Serve with naan bread and rice.



It's a balancing act

Our balance is something many us take for granted, but everyone can benefit from improving it. Balance training exercises strengthen core muscles and improves stability. It can help anyone at any age. Athletes find it can make them more powerful and agile - seniors can use it to prevent falls and to maintain their independence.

Falling as we get older is quite common, and although most falls don't cause serious injury they can leave the affected person feeling quite distressed and vulnerable. Falls can be caused by dehydration, poor circulation, medical conditions such as stroke and Parkinson's disease, heart conditions and by the taking of certain prescription medication that may affect your blood pressure.

If you feel that yourself, a friend or a family member is struggling with their balance

then there are steps that can be taken to reduce the risk of falling, and importantly to reduce the risk of serious injuries as a result of a fall.A 2013 study published in the peerreviewed British Medical Journal found that balance exercise programs reduced falls that cause injuries by 37%, serious injuries by 43%, and broken bones by 61%.

Here are 6 things you can do to stay on your feet

I. Stay physically active

Plan an exercise program that is right for you. Keep strong and mobile by walking or jogging, swimming, climbing stairs, doing Yoga or Tai Chi and performing body weight exercises such as squats and lunges. The NHS website provides excellent advice on balance exercises as well as exercise in general.

2. Have your eyes and ears tested Even small changes to your eyesight can lead to a fall. Wear your glasses or contact lenses when you need them. Earwax build up can lead to vertigo which will affect your balance. 3. Find out about the side effects of

vour medication

Certain drugs can make you drowsy or can cause dizziness. Check with your GP or pharmacist if you think your medication is affecting your balance.

4. Limit your alcohol intake Even a small amount of alcohol can affect your balance, coordination and reflexes.

5. Stand up slowly

Getting up too quickly can cause a sudden drop in your blood pressure. This can make you wobbly. Get your blood pressure checked when lying and standing if you think this is a problem that affects you.

6. Use a walking aid if you feel unsteady

The use of a stick, cane or a walker can prevent falls and gives you additional stability.
