

How muscles repair: advice on how to speed up your recovery. by David Hanson

We probably all know the feeling and the pain associated with a pulled or strained muscle - the inability to move freely and the impact it has on our function. If you enjoy exercise then a pulled muscle can be a nightmare if the affected muscle stops you from doing your workout and giving you that 'endorphin high'. If you've strained a muscle in your lower back, sitting at your work station or doing housework will be extremely painful or even impossible to do.


A tear or strain happens when the muscles have been stretched or overworked too quickly. Luckily, our bodies are remarkable in that they have the ability to regenerate and repair and damaged muscles do this very effectively. Just picture that sprinter flying down the straight in the Olympic 100 metres final only to pull up sharply clutching the back of their thigh. The pain and anguish etched all over their face tells you that they've pulled their hamstring - a group of 3 powerful muscles responsible for producing speed of movement. If you've done this you'll know just how painful and debilitating a hamstring tear is, but that sprinter will perhaps be out injured for 4 to 6 weeks before they return to sprinting as quickly as they ever have with no long term detriment to their performance.


When you tear a muscle the most important advice that I can give you is to STOP! The RICE principle which stands for Rest, Ice, Compression and Elevation should be followed for the first 48 to 72 hours. Under no. circumstance should heat in the form of a hot water bottle, wheat bag or a hot bath or shower be applied to the injured area. This will increase blood flow to the damaged area and increase bleeding, inflammation and swelling making your pain worse and increasing your recovery time. Compression of the injured area with a bandage and elevation where the affected muscle is raised so that it is higher than the heart will further help to control swelling and inflammation.

Pain from a torn muscle should start to ease considerably within one week as the injury begins to repair. During this repair process a cell called a macrophage is introduced into the injured site and this 'eats' and 'cleans away' the dead tissue and dry blood caused by the injury. Once this is complete another cell, called a satellite cell, is released into the injured area. Satellite cells transform into myoblast cells, which group together to create new muscle fibres. However, unlike a broken bone that is repaired by regenerating only new bone, an injured muscle is not replaced with only new muscle fibres. Another cell, called a fibroblast, also produces connective tissue at the injured site. It is a combination of connective tissue and muscle fibres that repair the injured muscle. This repair phase is usually peaking at around 2 weeks after injury and it is usually at this point that you can return safely return to some light activities in which the injured area is put under some gentle loading.

Typically, static or isometric exercises where the muscle contracts but there is no movement of the joint or limb, are implemented first. Thereafter, isotonic exercises that involve joint movements are introduced. This, in combination with gentle stretching, is standard during the repair phase.

The final stage of muscle repair is the remodelling phase. During this phase the regenerating muscle fibres and connective tissue continue to mature and are being oriented into the final scar tissue. This stage is important for the manner in which the scar tissue is being layed down. The aim is to get the fibres within this new scar tissue to run in straight lines which is typical of normal muscle tissue. Poorly aligned scar tissue is likely to break down and reinjury can occur. Treatment during this stage should include some manual therapy such as massage and soft tissue mobilisation to enhance the final scar tissue formation and allow it to absorb the load of exercise as we return back to full function.
