BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

A unique chance to see items from the Blavatnik Honresfield Library collection before they are taken off display for landmark new exhibition Becoming the Brontës, bringing together material that has not been seen by the public for over 80 years.

In 2022 the Blavatnik Honresfield Library, a highly important collection featuring printed books and manuscripts by Charlotte Brontë and Emily Brontë, was purchased for the nation by the Friends of the National Libraries. The campaign to save the library was led by the Friends of the National Libraries and a consortium of libraries and writers' houses, including the British Library and the Brontë Parsonage Museum.



One of the most significant items from the collection is one of the famous little books produced by Charlotte Brontë, currently on display here in Haworth. The little books are best known for the size of their tiny handwriting (pictured), a trait shared by all the Brontë siblings. The book will be taken off display later this month to be transferred to a new exhibition in Leeds, which sees items from the Blavatnik Honresfield Library collection brought together for the first time, so there are only a few more weeks to see these special items on your doorstep! **Becoming the Brontës** is a free exhibition within the Treasures of the Brotherton Gallery in Leeds, co-curated by the University of Leeds, the British Library and the Brontë Parsonage Museum. Poulet Sauté Au Vinaigre



Chicken sautéed in vinegar

This is a simple, quick and economical recipe that gives supermarket chickens some taste; it sounds much posher if it's given its French name of

"Poulet Sauté Au Vinaigre".

A whole chicken is much cheaper and you can use the carcass and wings to make a stock for a soup or gravy too. If you don't know how to joint a chicken, use two chicken thigh joints (bone in) per

person.

I like to serve this dish with plain boiled new potatoes and a green salad.

Do not buy bagged salad leaves, they're nasty & expensive. Buy a couple of whichever lettuce you think looks nice, roughly chop, chuck in a big bowl, add a bit of salt, a squirt of lemon juice, a few grinds of black pepper, a glug of olive oil & yer done, a fraction of the price & tastes better!

Ingredients

I medium / large chicken 1.5kg / 2kg 'ish, jointed, or 8 chicken thighs 150g of unsalted butter 2 tablespoons of olive oil I x 400g tin of tomatoes 300 ml red wine vinegar 400ml chicken stock (or a stock cube) 2 tablespoons of chopped flat leaf parsley, chopped (I small supermarket bag) Salt & Black pepper

Method

You need a large and wide stove top pot for this recipe, big enough to hold he chicken joints with room to spare. Joint the chicken into 8 pieces, I really encourage you to do this, it is very easy. Skin them or leave the skin on as you prefer. Season the chicken joints well with salt and black pepper.

Put your pot on a medium to high heat. After a minute or so, add the oil and then half of the butter. When the butter starts to bubble and foam, add your chicken joints and fry until well coloured, you will need to shake the pan and turn the joints occasionally to prevent them sticking and burning.

Once the joints are coloured to your liking, chuck in the tomatoes, stir well occasionally, until the sauce is starting to stick to the bottom of the pot. Now tip in the vinegar and simmer till almost back to the sticky sauce you had earlier. Add the chicken stock, continue simmering until the sauce has reduced to the thickness you like, stirring occasionally. Remove the chicken joints and transfer to a warm plate. Add the remaining butter and the chopped parsley to your sauce, stir well until the butter has melted then pour over the chicken joints.

Rest for a minute or so, (you and the chicken) then dish up. ~ Martin Lingard

After all the excitement of hosting Flying Scotsman stay with us during May and the focus on steam, we haven't forgotten that our heritage includes diesel traction. With that in mind, we are looking forward to welcoming a fleet of visiting locomotives to our Diesel Gala which runs from 23rd-25th lune, when we run diesel-hauled services to reflect an important period in railway locomotives that are still running on the mainline, so it's a part of history that is still being made.

Reflecting on the various elements of the Railway's 150+ year history is always challenging, not least when we have to consider which elements of the history to preserve. The decision to reflect a more recent period of that history when we acquired a "Pacer" diesel multiple unit when it was made available as the type was being withdrawn from mainline traffic. They have been a key member of the West Yorkshire of service in 2020, we felt it important and right to acquire and restore an example to reflect their place in our local railway history. As a result, you can now enjoy a trip on our 144 Pacer, lovingly restored and looking very striking in its original 1986 red West Yorkshire Metro livery. The 144 operates regularly in the "diesel" path on the timetable, which can be found on the website.

Of course, we continue to cater for those of us who visit the Railway to enjoy steamhauled trains, and so run steam trains every weekend (other than during the diesel gala). Keeping the fleet operational requires hours and hours of volunteer effort to deal with the maintenance of the steam locomotives, some of which are now well over 100 years old. Our carriages are also history. Indeed, we will welcome some getting increasingly elderly, with most dating back to the 1960s. As a result, we are always looking for volunteers to join our team, particularly if you would have the skills and time to join our behind-the-scenes engineering teams, but also our front-ofhouse operational departments. There are so many duties involved in keeping the wheels turning, from maintaining the station buildings, the track and the other elements of the Railway's infrastructure, as well as staffing the stations, shops and catering outlets, through to operating the locomotives and guarding the trains. We offer full training to help volunteers gain (and beyond) rail transport fleet since the the necessary "competencies" for our mid-1980s, so when they were taken out roles, and you would be joining a group of well over 700 volunteers, supported by a small team of paid staff. We work together to keep our bit of Railway history alive, and we all look forward to welcoming you on board soon.
