

You may have noticed the neon sign that appeared Upstairs at Pennybank House at the top of Haworth Main Street prior to Christmas. The sign reads "*No coward soul is mine*," a quote from a poem by Emily Brontë.

The neon light is formed in cursive script that renders it challenging to read, not

unlike the poet's penmanship, which if you visit the Parsonage Museum a few steps away, you can see for yourself, as there is much authentic Brontë ephemera that fills the display cabinets in that luminous place.

It is best to view the sign between dusk and dawn to appreciate its pink glow. During the day, it is of little consequence or effect.

l'm not a literary scholar, nor a Brontë expert, but I do consider myself a

Brontë fan. Having lived in and around Bradford for over thirty years, I am steeped in an awareness and appreciation for the petite sisters from Haworth (and born in Thornton) who rocked the literary world with their expansive and wild thoughts.

I think of "No coward soul is mine" as a

In my mind, it is an affirmation of epic proportions, deeply supportive and

intentions both internally and externally to respond to life that felt restricted and under threat in 2020. I was under pressure and I wanted to be in a position to withstand the tumultuous conditions that were unfolding in the world.

In varying degrees we have all been traumatised by events of the past two years.

I found wells of reserve that were surprising and noticeable. I felt brave in some inexplicable way.

Something I had been mulling over as I put together the application for the funding of this work was the notion of being 'in keeping with.' Buildings being 'in keeping with' other buildings. The village of Haworth being an environment that needed to be maintained and preserved 'in keeping with' its heritage. I asked myself why and how this concept and principle was so important.

The idea of fitting in, quietly blending with structures, and not making a fuss was a subject of interest to me. A British sense of taste and understatement was competing with my desire to create a bright bold flashing neon sign, much more 'in keeping with' my own expression of thought. It seemed to me that a Las Vegas style sign

would be a fabulous homage worthy of the mighty Emily Brontë.

In the end, the piece stands alone without the Vegas treatment. (Alas, no flashing cowgirl swinging her leg).

I think it is suitably understated.

More importantly, I wonder how Emily would react to her words being displayed in bright electric pink, illuminating her neighbourhood, one hundred and seventy four years after her death.

Resilient is a temporary art work and neon sign that is in place (2-4 West Lane, Haworth) until mid March. Upstairs at Pennybank will host a number of discussions relating to the subject of resilence and the ways individuals are recovering from COVID 19 and the global pandemic. (photos by John Sargent)



WINTER MINESTRONE by Martin Lingard

Adapted over the years from an old River Café recipe, this has become a family favourite. It becomes a vegan recipe if you omit the bacon and chorizo, use vegetable stock and just use the herb garnish. It's very cheap and easy, tasty and healthy. It does take an hour or two including prep' but I used to cook it the night before, after the kids had gone to bed, up to the point of adding the last 1/4 of cabbage, then finish it off the following teatime. You can have dinner on the table within 15 minutes of getting back from work.

Ingredients (feeds 5 well) Olive oil

4 rashers smoked streaky bacon, chopped 4 medium carrots, peeled and chopped 2 medium onions, peeled and chopped I head of celery, leaves removed and reserved

I head of garlic, cloves peeled

- 3 4lbs of winter greens (kale, cavolo nero, spring cabbage, savoy etc - tough stalks removed and shredded)
- I bunch flat leaf parsley, finely chopped 400g tin plum tomatoes
- 400g tin of white beans (cannellini, haricot)
- I litre of chicken or vegetable stock
- I chorizo ring, peeled and sliced
- Salt & Pepper
- Parmesan, grated

Method

Add a few good glugs of olive oil into your favourite stove top pot and set over a medium to low heat.

If using, add your bacon and cook until the fat starts to run but before it takes colour. Now add the roughly chopped carrots, celery and onions and cook slowly for at least 30 minutes, stirring frequently until all is very soft, adding the peeled garlic cloves roughly halfway through.

Add the tomatoes and cook for a further 5-10 minutes.

Tip in the white beans and their liquid, add the stock and $\frac{3}{4}$ of your shredded cabbages / kale, half of the chopped parsley and the chorizo if using.

Bring to the boil, reduce the heat and simmer, partially covered for 30 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Season to taste with salt and black pepper. Add the remaining shredded cabbages and simmer for a further 5 minutes. Finely chop the reserved celery leaves and mix with the remaining parsley.

Ladle the soup into warm bowls, sprinkle some of the chopped parsley & celery leaves and the grated parmesan over each bowl, with a slug of extra olive oil, and

serve with crusty bread. This is one of those meals which gets even better overnight and heated up again the

next day - and freezes well too.





It's sometimes a bit easy to overlook a gem on the doorstep, and you are very fortunate in that you have a gem very near you and - even better you get a discount as a local resident Haworth family-focused "Witches when you visit it. The Railway offers residents of BD20/21/22 up to 50% off standard rail fares and a 10% discount on purchases from the ontrain buffet car. You can save more than the annual cost of the railcard in one visit, so please download the application form from the Railway's website and bring it, a passport-sized photo and recent proof of address to your local KWVR station when trains are running and start saving.

There will be plenty of opportunities to make use of your railcard because as well as our regular weekend steam maintenance as well as the front of trains, the Wednesday diesel rail car service recommences in March before we add more days in June and then run all week in the summer as well as the Easter holidays.


