BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

Stitching Workshops with the Museum

This month, we hear from Diane Fare, our Outreach Officer at the Brontë Parsonage Museum:

I'm really excited about a new project we're running - a series of informal stitching workshops open to all.

Textile artist, Claire Wellesley-Smith, will lead the workshops. I've joined Claire before on textile projects; she has over twenty years' experience working with different community groups. Claire will provide her own examples: a daily stitch journal completed over ten years; another created over a year; and a collaborative community project made by thirty local women during the first Covid-19 lockdown and exhibited internationally.

There's no pressure to produce a final piece though – everyone's welcome to learn new techniques or develop existing skills. I struggle to sew on a button, so I'm looking forward to practising some new stitches! We have samplers in the collection made by the young Brontë sisters, and we can look to these for inspiration – but in the Brontës' time, samplers were educational exercises, teaching obedience and patience, so it's worth considering how stitching can be employed for more radical purposes, or as a simple storytelling tool. The Brontës are famous for their 'little books' – there's an opportunity here to create a little book of stitches!

Claire will provide materials, although people are welcome to bring their own equipment (particularly after the first session) and the work is designed to be portable, so people can take their work home to stitch between sessions if they like!



There's no assumption of familiarity with the Museum, or the Brontës for that matter. The workshops will take place in the Old School Room across from the Museum, so toilet facilities are available and coffee. tea. and biscuits will be provided.

There's no need to book – just turn up whenever you feel like it and stay as long as you like. The dates will be advertised seasonally on our website and on flyers around Haworth, but they'll normally run every other Thursday (depending on school holiday dates, so always check ahead). Sessions are from 10am to 12 noon and are FREE. The next dates are 7 and 21 March, and 11 and 25 April. With wellbeing and connection in mind, I hope people will see the workshops as not only an opportunity to develop their skills, but to enjoy some company. I really hope to meet some of you there! Swollen knee joints -

Causes and things you need to know

A swollen knee, also know as a joint effusion or 'water on the knee', occurs when excess fluid collects in and around your knee joint. It may be the result of trauma, overuse, injury or of an underlying disease or condition.

Injuries

Damage to any part of your knee can cause excess joint fluid to accumulate. Injuries that can cause fluid build up in

and around the knee joint include:

- a torn ligament, particularly the anterior cruciate ligament (ACL)
- a cartilage (meniscus) tear
- irritation of the joint from overuse
- broken bones. Diseases and

conditions

Underlying diseases and conditions that can produce fluid build up in and around the joint include:

- osteoarthritis rheumatoid arthritis
- infection gout pseudogout
- bursitis cysts tumour

Signs and symptoms typically include:

• **Swelling.** The skin around your kneecap can puff up noticeably, especially when you compare the affected knee to your non-affected one.

• **Stiffness.** When your knee joint contains excess fluid, you might not be able to bend or straighten your leg completely.

• **Pain.** Depending on the cause of the fluid build up, your knee might be very painful - to the point it becomes impossible to weight bear. A swollen knee is typically the result of a traumatic injury or a chronic health condition such as osteoarthritis.

An injury that has resulted from a traumatic injury to the knee such as a high impact colision, e.g. skiing accident, a high-impact tackle in a sports such as football or rugby, or any incident where a loud popping soundisheard oris felt will require carefulinvestigation and management. If the joint swells up immediately or continues to swell over a 24-hour period and the joint feels warm then you might have ruptured one of the key stabilising ligaments in your knee, the anterior cruciate ligament (ACL). An injury that leads to a complete rupture, or a partial rupture that leads to instability of the ACL will require reconstructive surgery if you are very acive in sport and wish to continue, or have a job that requires knee strength and stability to keep you and others safe such as in construction.

The most common reason to have a swollen knee is as a result of osteoarthritis (OA). An estimated 10 million people (6 million women and 4 million men) in the UK are affected by OA with an estimated 5.4 million affected by OA of the knee. It causes the cartilage, which acts as the cushioning between the bones of your knee, to wear away and leads to pain, swelling and stiffness. This pain is especially more significant in the morning or after bouts of inactivity. The average age of symptom onset is 55 years and the disease typically worsens as you get older.

Conclusion

A swollen knee joint is typically the result of a traumatic injury or a sign of osteoarthritis. If you have swollen knee or knees use the RICE protocol of Rest, Ice, Compression and Elevation to help reduce the swelling which in turn will help to reduce your levels of pain. Remember, true elevation of a joint involves elevating and maintaining the affected swollen joint in a position that is higher than the level of your heart. A foot placed upon a footstool will not achieve elevation unless you are lying flat on your back on the floor!

If your pain is manageable and you are able to do some exercises you should:

- strengthen the muscles around your knee.
- choose low-impact exercises.

• maintain a healthy weight. Excess weight contributes to the wear-and-tear damage that can lead to an increase in the swelling of an already swollen knee. ~ David Hanson

Boiled Bacon with Chickpeas Cocido Gallego



Hopefully by the time this goes to print, spring will be in sight. This is a good winter warmer from Galicia, in Northern Spain, that should sustain you to the end of winter.

You can use dried or tinned chickpeas. The beauty of this dish is you can mix and match the ham / bacon joints depending on what you can find; I like to use a ham hock and a bacon collar joint but you could use bacon ribs, a joint of streaky bacon or a small gammon joint. I use spring cabbage but savoy cabbage can also be used.

Ingredients (serves 6)

- Ikg bacon collar joint
- I ham hock
- 4 bay leaves
- I whole garlic bulb, halved
- 600g dried chickpeas (or 2 x 400g tins)
- 2 onions, peeled
- 8 cloves
- I tsp black peppercorns
- 2 large carrots, peeled and cut into chunks
- 2 celery stalks, cut into chunks
- 6 medium potatoes, peeled and cut into chunks
- 6 small chorizo sausages
- I black pudding
- Spring cabbage (or savoy), thick stalks removed, roughly sliced

Method

You need your largest stovetop pot for this recipe; I use a big stockpot. The night before you plan to eat, put your bacon / ham / gammon in your pot, if using dried chickpeas, chuck those in too, cover with cold water and leave to soak overnight. The following day, fish out your meat, and tip the water away (remembering to drain the chickpeas into a colander).



Put the meat back

into your pot, cover with fresh water and bring to the boil. Drain again, cover with fresh water and return to the heat. Stud your onions with the cloves and chuck into the pot, along with garlic, onions, studded with cloves, bay leaves, peppercorns and chickpeas (if using dried). Bring to a gentle simmer and cook for 90 minutes. Now lob in your potatoes, carrots, celery, chickpeas (if using tinned), chorizo and black pudding. Return to a gentle simmer and cook for another 20 minutes until the carrots and potatoes are cooked. Now turn off the heat, measure 500ml of the broth into a separate pan, bring to a rolling boil, add your cabbage and cook for 5 minutes. Turn off the heat.

To serve, fish out the meat, sausage and black pudding, carve the meat and transfer onto a large warmed serving plate.

Similarly, spoon out the potatoes, carrots and onto a warmed dish. Drain the cabbage and serve separately in another warmed dish. Finally, drain your pot into a colander over a bowl, discard the onion and garlic and serve the chickpeas in a small bowl. Now ladle some of the broth into a gravy jug and bring everything to the table so you and your guests can dig in! ~ Martin Lingard
