

This was one of my favourite things to order at a Jamaican restaurant I used to go to when I lived in Coventry. I've missed eating it since I came up here so I've recreated

it myself, by trial and error. This is the closest I've got and I'm pleased with how it has come out. It should be served with a Jamaican roti flatbread but I cheat and buy ready made naan breads from the supermarket. This is cheap, healthy, filling and vegan if you use the coconut milk option rather than the single cream. The turmeric, cumin, coriander, allspice, cayenne, fenugreek and cayenne can be substituted with 3 tablespoons of a mild curry powder if necessary. This feeds 4 people well.

Ingredients

2 tablespoons of groundnut oil

I large onion, finely chopped

4 garlic cloves, finely chopped

I Scotch bonnet chilli, halved (if you don't like hot spice, remove the seeds or use half a teaspoon of dried chilli flakes)

I bunch of spring onions, finely chopped I small bunch of fresh thyme

I tablespoon of freshly grated ginger

 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of turmeric powder

I teaspoon of ground cumin
I teaspoon of ground coriander

12 whole allspice berries (or I teaspoon of ground allspice)

½ teaspoon of ground cayenne pepper

 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of fenugreek powder

I x 400g tin of plum tomatoes

2 x 400g tins of chickpeas

600g potatoes, peeled, diced, rinsed and drained

500g of frozen chopped spinach, boiled and drained

0.5 litre vegetable stock
400ml coconut milk (or single cream)
Salt

Method

Take a large stovetop pot with a well-fitting lid, place over a medium heat, add the oil and chuck in your onions. Soften for several minutes, stirring frequently and turning the heat down to low before they start to brown. Add your garlic and stir as it softens for another minute or two. Now add your Scotch bonnet chilli, spring onions, thyme, ginger and turmeric, cumin, coriander, allspice berries, keep stirring for another minute or so, adding a splash of water if the spices start to stick to the bottom of your pot. Now lob in your tomatoes, chickpeas, potatoes, spinach, stock and cream. Turn up the heat, bring to a gently simmer, pop on a lid, reduce the heat and leave to simmer for a good 40 minutes, stirring once or twice. Test the potatoes are soft with a fork. If they are, mash a few of them up with the back of the fork to thicken your sauce. If still firm, add a little more water and test again in 5 minutes or so.

Season with salt to taste and serve in large bowls with warm naan breads or rotis.







BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

A preview of new installation Hardy and Free by Bradford-based artist and photographer Carolyn Mendelsohn, celebrating the powerful connection between the Yorkshire landscape and the women who live and work here.



Hardy and Free by Carolyn Mendelsohn is a new installation commissioned by the Brontë Parsonage Museum as part of its Contemporary Arts programme. The Contemporary Arts programme showcases a vibrant range of work by artists and writers aiming to unearth new connections with the life and literature of the Brontës, and the Museum collection. Recent exhibits include Secret. Life in the South Pennines by Angie Rogers and Fragments of a Dress by Bingley-based textile artist Hannah Lamb. Inspired by the wild spirit of the Brontës, Hardy and Free celebrates the female connection to nature and examines how living in tune with the land can be an inspiring and important aspect of everyday

life for Yorkshire women. The installation

combines projection, soundscapes, personal

items and photography to tell the unique stories of twelve women living and working in the Bradford district, and the landscapes that inspire them.

"I wanted to create work that would be



a telling of the stories and a celebration of the women who live or have a relationship with Yorkshire from a range of backgrounds and ages with a rich variety of stories and connections to nature." - Carolyn Mendelsohn

During the early months of 2023, Carolyn invited women of differing ages and backgrounds to take her on a journey to places that are special to them. The result is a stunning audio-visual installation that transports you beyond the walls of the Museum to magnificent Yorkshire landscapes, featuring images of well-known local landmarks Brontë Falls and Top Withins, as well as more personal locations such as Bradford allotments and working



By the time you are reading this in early May 2023, St Michael's church in Haworth should be (hopefully) appointing a new priest (Peter Mullins having retired last September). There is a unique organisation in Haworth who have a veto on who the priest is and provide a fascinating twist to the Haworth Church story.

In 1559 (before even I was born!) the people of Haworth got a letter from the

Archbishop of York effectively saying 'You have got a priest - get him paid properly.' Haworth is in trouble with the Anglican church! Some rich local people got a fortune together (£36) and used it to buy 3 or 5 farms (records vary) in Stanbury; they installed tenant farmers, collected the rent and paid it to the priest - problem solved! The catch is they wanted a say in who the priest is. These folk became the Haworth Land Trustees and exist to this day.

The Land Trustees wanted William Grimshaw to be their priest in 1742 and the Vicar of Bradford (he was the boss then) didn't. The matter went to (ecclesiastical) court and the Trustees won. A different Vicar of Bradford wanted to give the job of Curate at Haworth to Patrick Bronte in 1819 but the Trustees hadn't been consulted and refused him so



the Vicar made Samuel Redhead the priest, again, without talking to the Land Trustees. The people of Haworth weren't having this so they made such a noise with their clogs that Redhead couldn't be heard, had a man riding up and down the aisles on a donkey and encouraged a drunken chimney sweep to hug Redhead. On Redhead's 3rd Sunday he had to flee to the Black Bull pub for sanctuary and they had to smuggle him out of a back window! At last the Vicar spoke with the Trustees who (because they had been asked (nicely?)) accepted Patrick Bronte in 1820 and the rest (as they say) is
