

What is an eBike? An electric bike, or eBike, is a bicycle equipped with an electric motor to assist you when you're pedalling. The motor gets its power from a rechargeable battery mounted on the bike. The motor helps you rather than propels you on its own. As a result, you need to pedal to get that assistance.

After serious consideration about which bikes to use, they teamed up with Giant Halifax and chose the Giant Fathom Pro, which has proven rugged enough to deal with the back waters of Haworth and the surrounding terrain. Mark (Giant) was kind enough to teach the pair servicing skills. All bikes receive daily checks upon hire







Association of Ukrainians in Great Britain – Keighley Branch Supporting new arrivals in the District

There has been an active Ukrainian community in Keighley since the late 1940's. Many Ukrainians came to the UK as

Displaced persons, leaving their homeland with nothing but the clothes on their backs, arriving at the local Displaced Persons camp in Silsden.

After leaving the camps Ukrainians built their lives in the district amongst diverse communities. Interacting with other

cultures and amongst themselves, the Ukrainian community came together and became part of the Association of Ukrainians in Great Britain in 1948. Initially renting premises in Fleece Street, Keighley, which was their social centre, the community grew and when they needed a bigger premises they purchased Mayfield House in Keighley. People from all communities would attend concerts, dances, weddings and other events

at the centre. The Keighley Ukrainian community had a choir, a dance group and a Ukrainian School for its young people. Over the years the community got smaller, and moved to a smaller premises in Henry Street, Keighley town centre.

The 'Keighley Ukrainian Cultural and Community Centre' is now run by Keighley's second and third generations of Ukrainians. The heritage and traditions are lovingly shared and celebrated.

Sadly, in February this year hostilities widened in Ukraine and the whole of the country was again under threat. Thankfully, the Ukrainian Centre in Keighley opened its doors for refugees and hosts. Every Thursday between I lam and Ipm it holds 'get to know each other' sessions for the Ukrainians who have fled their homeland. The community is thriving once more, helping those in the same situation as those who arrived in the late 1940s. The centre is run by members of the existing Ukrainian speaking community, volunteers

from far and wide, and is attended by outside agencies who offer support and advice. The community is helping our guests to settle and integrate into the wider community. Over a cuppa and a butty, everyone who attends is made to feel welcome. Links have been forged with organisations such as the Salvation Army, Living Lights (and others), the Community Champions from Asda and Morrisons - who have all provide food and other provisions for donated food, clothing, toys and toiletries. Residents from





We are sitting in the middle of a community of good neighbours. Or so it seemed to me when Covid hit.

We had thought that the churches would need to run a support scheme. Shopping for those who couldn't get out. Phoning the lonely. And so on. We had several offers of people willing to be part of this, so we felt ready to do our bit.

But the requests simply didn't come in. At least, not in the quantity we expected. It turned out that for most people (albeit not all) family and neighbours were simply getting on with it. The strength of our communities exceeded what we might have expected.

So where might we be now as the cost of living crisis kicks in? Where will we be when heating needs putting on again as autumn begins? Resilient communities and good neighbours will obviously still be key. But our guess is that this time more will be needed. In Haworth we are already planning one consultation. At **7.00 p.m. on Thursday 8th September at West Lane Baptist Church a number of people active in the community are inviting anyone interested to join them.**

'Let us share ideas and concerns and think about possible ways forward.' There are some innovative ideas out there already. Shared cooking and shared warm spaces are among them. It will be interesting and important to explore whether there are more.

'Give us this day our daily bread' has always been part of the central Christian prayer. We want to pray it and plan it in new ways ready of this autumn and winter.
