# Nel's cherry, amaretto and white chocolate layered trifle

Serves 12

2 tubs (400g) philadelphia soft cheese 300g white chocolate

500ml double cream (not whipping cream) 2 packs (500g) amaretti biscuits

2 x 400g packs frozen cherries defrosted 1 jar seedless raspberry or cherry jam 50g almonds

This is made in several simple stages:

#### White chocolate mix

- 1. Melt 200g of white chocolate, along with 2 tablespoons of the cream. (You can do this in the microwave for 30 seconds on medium power. Stir and repeat until melted1
- 2. Whip 400ml of the double cream until firm (cream whips much more easily if it is at room temperature)
- 3. In a large bowl mix the cream cheese and melted chocolate until smooth, and then add the whipped cream. Stir well and leave on one side

### Fruit laver

Put aside 8 cherries. Place the iam and the the fruit mixture, and a third of the white rest of the fruit in a bowl and microwave until just warm and the jam is melted. Stir through.

#### Amaretti biscuits

Put 8 biscuits on one side. Lightly crush the rest, so they are around 1/3 of their original biscuit size

White chocolate and almond topping Keeping aside 2 squares, gently melt the rest of the white chocolate with 5 tablespoons double cream.

Keep aside a few whole almonds for decoration; coarsely chop the rest of the almonds, and fold into the chocolate



This is a trifle which will look great on any Christmas or New Year table and is incredibly easy to make. Why not make your own variation using dark and white chocolate (like this photo), or add a splash of amaretto or baileys to the chocolate mixture for a really decadent dinner party dessert.

#### To assemble...

In a large trifle bowl, place a third of the crushed biscuits, cover with a third of chocolate mix

Repeat twice, finishing with a layer of the white chocolate mix.

Top with the white chocolate and almond topping, and decorate using the set aside amaretto biscuits, almonds and cherries. Finally, cover with a dusting of grated white chocolate, stand back and take a bow! I remember going for the tree with my father, the three of us, my brother, sister and I helping him to carry it the half

mile or so home, often through a faint scattering of snow: the evocative scent of pine redolent of so many Christmases past and dad rousing us to a state of high excitement with his enthusiastic discourse on the height, width and wonder of the tree and how it would look once decorated. The ceremony with which the box of Christmas decorations was brought down and opened, each precious bauble carefully taken from the tissue paper encasing it. The feeling of anticipation building, we looked forward to the Christmas eve buffet, and the chocolates dangling tantalisingly from the branches of the tree in their gilded wrappers held all the promise of any magical kingdom ever spoken of, the chocolate tasting better than at any other time of the year. It is the sense of ceremony and preparation that creates the anticipation for all things wonderful. Slow down that preparation and you will extend and intensify the magic as you work. Filling the run up to Christmas with lots of mini celebrations in the form of family traditions and rituals. such as the making of the cake, the pudding, or even a few mince pies ( my family take it in turns to stir wishes into the cake before it goes into the oven) will help to make Christmas preparations more of a pleasure and less of a chore. If you prefer not to get involved in the culinary aspect of the season take pleasure from seeking out the best that you can afford. Everybody loves arriving home with edible treasures to savour and relish; glossy clementines, mahogany chestnuts, fine cheeses, fresh figs and exquisite hand made chocolates. A succulent ham infused with wine and herbs, chutneys, sauces and brandy butter: marzipan, mince pies and tiny chocolate desserts. Chocolate truffles are very easy to make and boxed and ribboned with a hand made label they make as good a gift, if not better ( much better in my opinion) than any mass produced chain store trinket. 


"I am aware of the benefits of keeping trade local and I am all too happy to make my team available for more local business; it just isn't something I have focussed on in the past."





### Practice Uncommon Appreciation

by Jack Canfield

A recent management study revealed that 46% of employees leaving a company do so because they feel unappreciated; 61% said their bosses don't place much importance on them as people; and 88% said they don't receive acknowledgement for the work they do.

Whether you are an entrepreneur, manager, teacher, parent, coach or simply a friend, if you want to be successful with other people, you must master the art of appreciation. I've never known anyone to complain about receiving too much positive feedback. Have you? In fact, just the opposite is true.

#### **Keeping Score**

When I first learned about the power of appreciation, it made total sense to me. However, it was still something that I forgot to do. I hadn't yet turned it into a habit. A valuable technique that I employed to help me lock in this new habit was to carry a 3" x 5" card in my pocket all day, and every time I acknowledged and appreciated someone. I would place a check mark on the card. I would not allow myself to go to bed until I had appreciated 10 people. I did whatever it took until it became an unconscious habit. I did this every single day for 6 months-until I no longer needed the card to remind me.

#### Who Cares?

If asked, could you name the five wealthiest people in the world, or five people who have won the Nobel Prize, or the last five Academy Award winners for best actor and actress?

The point is none of us remembers the headliners of yesterday. These are no

second-rate achievers either; they are the best in their fields.

But if I asked you to list five teachers or mentors who believed in and encouraged you, five friends who have helped you through a difficult time, five people who have taught you something worthwhile, or five people who have made you feel appreciated and special – that's much easier to do, isn't it?

That's because the people who make a difference in your life aren't the ones with the most credentials, the most money, or the most awards. They're the ones who care. If you want to be remembered for being important to someone else's life, make them feel appreciated.

Appreciation as a Secret of Success

Another important reason for being in a state of appreciation as often as possible is that when you are in such a state, you are in one of the highest emotional states possible.

When you are in a state of appreciation and gratitude, you are in a state of abundance. You are appreciating what you do instead of focusing on, and complaining about, what you don't have. Your focus is on what you have received... and you always get more of what you focus on. And because the law of attraction states that like attracts like, the more you are in a state of gratitude, the more you will attract to be grateful for. It becomes an upward-spiraling process of ever-increasing abundance that just keeps getting better and better.
