WORTH VALLEY WARBLER

BY THE BIRDMAN FROM HAWORTH

This month the theme is back and white – or is it? Things aren't always as they seem in the world of birds. We take a look at the magpie which has been doing very well in recent years and the lapwing whose numbers have fallen dramatically.

With a decline in many bird species you would have thought the success of a beautiful exotic looking bird would be reason to celebrate, but for many people, it is not. The magpie, which looks like an escapee from the tropical aviary with its striking long tail, has been persecuted



for many years. In the UK it is seen as a thief, a menace and in more recent years

as a big killer of songbirds. Entwined in human superstition and rituals; "One for sorrow, Two for joy," ... "Good morning Mr. Magpie," etc.; society likes to find its scape-goats and in this case it's a bird. Whilst the sight of a magpie taking a baby blackbird is distressing, we should try not to get too sentimental – it's nature. And whilst songbird numbers have declined, studies have shown that increasing magpie numbers are not the cause - the reasons are more complex - we just like simple solutions – black and white!

Towards the end of March lapwings become the star of the show. Whilst numbers have declined due to changing farming practices you can still get great views of them locally - around Leeshaw reservoir is a good local spot. From afar they look black and white, but when they settle, what was considered black, on closer observation, is actually bottle-green,

with bronze and magenta iridescence, set off with a distinctive bobbing head crest. Watch out for the amazing aerial courtship of the males. Their acrobatic show sees them dance across the skies twisting and looping at break-neck speed. They turn so tightly that their wing feathers produce a ripping noise similar to the sound you get when pull hard on the strings of a stunt kite. This combined with their famous "peewit" call produces a spectacle to rival any song and dance routine and what's more you'll get a matinee, afternoon and evening performance!

2007 was the centenary year of Rachel Carson's birth. "Breaking the Silence" is a one-person show, written and performed by Liz Rothschild described as "A poetic tour-de-force" by the Newbury Weekly News. Rachel Carson's discoveries remain as relevant and urgent as they were in 1962 and her personal and professional struggles to finish her research make a fascinating show.

"The show is not a history lesson," Liz Rothschild says, "nor is it about fear and despair. It is a love story. Through it you meet this remarkable woman, experience the natural world as she did, and hear stories she never told in her lifetime, and how they reverberate today."

Silent Spring is the name of the book written by Rachel Carson in September 1962. It is widely credited with helping launch the environmental movement in the West. When *Silent Spring* was published, Rachel Carson was already a well-known writer on natural history, but had not previously been a social critic. The book was widely read and inspired widespread public concerns with pesticides and pollution of the environment.

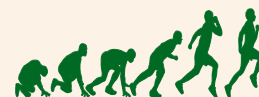

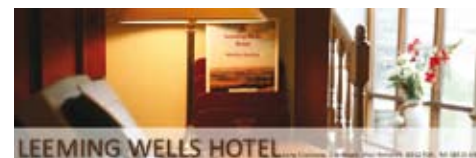
of questions but he had also written out his carefully considered answers for our discussions! It was evident that Lyndon was used to taking everything in hand and making things as easy as possible for people.

Need an excuse to get out of the house? Geocaching is the high tech version of hide and seek that is taking the country by storm. Invented in the U.S. in 2000 the idea of the game is to find a hidden cache of treasure using map co-ordinates and cryptic clues posted on the net. You'll need a Global Positioning System(GPS) although many Sat Navs may point you somewhere in the right direction. There are currently estimated to be around 480,000 geocaches currently placed in over 100 countries around the world and on all seven continents, including Antarctica. The treasure is usually of very little value. The fun is in finding it! For more details on the sport check out the founding website.

Being a nocturnal writer (due to pressures of work rather than choice) I often find myself sitting at the kitchen table,

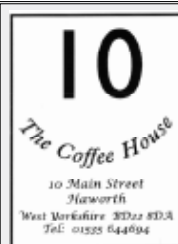

Oakworth Juniors Football Club, established in 1991, is now a thriving Club with over 300 children (boys and girls) training on a weekly basis. More recently there has been the start of an open age team and a ladies only team.

With all this activity and clearly an enthusiastic and vibrant Club, it is of the utmost importance that a suitable facility is built to accommodate the growing needs of this important community interest.

Many are aware of the imminent demolition of the former Bronte School by the council to make way for other developments. 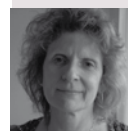
COUNSELLING

Counselling is a 'talking therapy' which helps you deal with emotional and personal problems without the use of drugs. The immediate aim of counselling is to help you cope with the problems which led you to seek help. The long term aim is to help you cope better in the future and develop your full potential. Talking to a counsellor enables you to explore feelings and anxieties in a safe, caring, confidential and non-judgemental environment. It helps individuals move towards a greater well being.

How do you choose the right counsellor? First of all you need to be sure they are competent. There are professional bodies such as the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP) which has a list of Accredited therapists, who meet the Associations standards of training and follow their code of ethics. The list can be viewed on their website www.bacp.co.uk. You also need to be sure that the counsellor is right for you. When you phone or email a counsellor you could ask them what experience they have. Have they had experience with the kind of problem you want to talk about? Can the counsellor see you regularly, at a time that suits you? Ask the counsellor how much they charge, is the cost negotiable? (For example, a lower rate for those on low income or who are students?) Do they charge for missed sessions?

It can be difficult to make the first contact but counsellors understand this and are there to listen and help you.

Spring is in the air. Hosts of golden daffodils are

sprouting up across the Worth Valley and clear blue skies and sunshine have laid waste to the intolerable frosts and thick blankets of snow. At least that's what it said in the script!

Nature these days seems to be improvised, making a yomp across the moors a difficult mission to plan. When we first moved here a friend of mine told me it was a walker's paradise and he wasn't kidding. Within days of settling we soon found ourselves ankle deep in muddy water, gasping in awe at the sweeping scenery before us, amazed at the abundant wild life. And that was just Keighley!

We soon found a favourite little route that took us through the woods behind Holden Park and over field and vale towards the wonderfully titled Slippery Ford. Other silly places within a reasonable ramble are Big End, Hole Bottom and Dick Slack.. It gets worse. Imagine asking for directions to Buttock??!! (It's near Pendle)

A more sensible idea is the walk across to Bronte Falls - if you can find somewhere to sit when you get there! Apart from realising the falls are pretty much a pathetic dribble we were disappointed to share this expected moment of solitude with several coach loads of tourists.

The popularity of all things Bronte hardly ever seems to wane and news of yet another TV version of Wuthering Heights is sure to entice more visitors to the region.

I saw the original film years ago, but couldn't remember much of it. Time and my lager sodden memory had served to confuse my recollection of the plot. I was lost somewhere between the brooding menace of Laurence Olivier's Heathcliffe and Kate Bush throwing her arms about like a demented windmill.

Apparently Kate's fans have been known to make pilgrimages to the area, probably for the same reason as Beatles' fans visit Abbey Road or Elvis Costello fans don't go to Chelsea.

After living here for several years I recently decided I really ought to read the book to see what all the fuss was about. I loved it. It was far darker than I imagined, but it has some lighter moments. You have to concentrate a bit mind. Various offspring pop up all over the place - sometimes swapping the surname and forename of their parents and then marrying each other's cousins. The whole business of birth and death seems to be treated with the same amount of reverence one might afford a cough or a fart. People in those days dropped like flies for the slightest reason, often keeling over from the minor of ailments, sometimes because they'd set off to Bronte Falls without a scarf or brolley.

Ms Bronte barely made it past the publication date of her novel - catching a cold at the funeral of her brother! I think my next hike will be to Top Withens and whilst there is some doubt over whether it is Wuthering Heights at least Ms. Bronte didn't venture several miles south west in search of inspiration. Or tourists might be making literary pilgrimages to a place called Pisser Clough!
