In 2026, Worth Valley Mag marks its twentieth year of publication. It is a milestone worth pausing for, not out of nostalgia, but out of respect for what

sustained, local endeavour can achieve over time.

Since 2006, our purpose has been simple: to

connect people to their place, and to help local businesses, organisations, and community life remain visible, viable, and valued. Over two decades, Worth Valley Mag, alongside its sister title, Aire Valley Mag, has supported well over 5,000 local businesses, from sole traders starting out to established employers providing livelihoods for others. Many have advertised with us for years; some for the full twenty. Others came, grew, adapted, and moved on. All were part of the local economic ecosystem. This magazine is, and has always been, a for-profit business. It has to be.

Sustainability matters. Printers must be paid, distribution organised, and people employed. But profitability has never been our primary driver. Our priorities have been sustainability, fairness, and added value for readers, advertisers, and the wider community.

That commitment shows up in practical ways. We pay local people to deliver the magazine, sustaining a 50-plus distribution team over the years ~ often providing first jobs, last jobs, and reliable local income. We keep advertising affordable so that small and micro-businesses are not priced out. We curate carefully, prioritising credibility and contribution over volume. And we reinvest time and energy into local life, supporting charities such as Manorlands Hospice, championing Fairtrade and ethical

trade, hosting forums, chairing partnerships, and working alongside civic, cultural, faith, and visitor-economy organisations.

In a world that has become increasingly noisy, fragmented, and transactional, trust has become a rare currency. Social media and digital platforms promise reach at ever-lower cost, but community consent cannot be bought cheaply. It is earned slowly by showing up, being accountable, and standing alongside the people you serve.

The Worth and Aire Valley magazines have never existed at arm's length. We stand shoulder to shoulder in the streets, around café counters and kitchen tables, as well as in local boardrooms. We use the businesses we feature. We attend local churches and events, belong to the local gym, frequent Keighley Picture House, support independent shops. Our children have gone to local schools. We love that we can still have milk delivered in glass bottles on the doorstep and buy eggs from a roadside stall. The past twenty years have not been without challenge. Economic shifts, rising costs, personal illness, and the Covid years tested every assumption. What carried the magazine through was not scale or speed, but relationships, a committed core team, loyal advertisers, engaged readers, and a shared belief that local still matters.

As we look ahead, new technologies will continue to change how media and business operate. Our task is not to resist change, but to use it wisely, improving what we do while protecting the human touch that has always been our foundation.

We enter our twentieth year grateful, proud, and attentive. Grateful for the trust placed in us. Proud of the quiet impact made over time. Attentive to the responsibility that comes with being part of a community's daily life.

We have always known this is a special place. It is heartening to see the wider

world catching up, with recent coverage from Condé Nast and The Guardian, and renewed international attention ahead of a major Hollywood Wuthering Heights release. We hope the district benefits from the spotlight. As with the 2014 Tour de France Grand Départ, and the 2025 City of Culture, we will welcome the attention while remaining grounded, rooted, and true to everyday community life.

Thank you to everyone who has read, delivered, advertised, collaborated, and believed in us. The Worth & Aire Valley Magazines exist as a result of consistent local support, careful stewardship, and a collective preference for sustainability, integrity, and community value over noise.







Paula loves reading, but an eye condition has made what was once a relaxing pastime frustrating. Then a friend mentioned Sight Airedale, a local charity based in Keighley. There, she tried a device that let her read electronic books with adjustable text size, and an app that read printed materials aloud.

Sight Airedale is a local independent charity supporting people across Keighley, Bingley, Skipton, Cross Hills, Silsden and Ilkley. They help people who are blind or partially sighted, or who have eye conditions such as macular degeneration, glaucoma or diabetic retinopathy that make reading standard text difficult, even with glasses.

Paula visited the Daily Living Shop at 31 Scott Street, Keighley (behind the library). She tried products designed to make life with sight loss easier, including a talking Air Fryer, and received private advice on issues

such as lighting.

She also tried a USB Talking Book player, giving her access to the charity's library of over 2,000 titles. Books are posted to her on a USB drive, listened to, then returned free of charge. Staff can also choose books for her based on favourite authors.

The charity's Technology Service helped her use her laptop by suggesting a large-key keyboard and simple setting changes. She later watched a tutorial on the charity's YouTube channel about screen magnifier software.

The Keighley Social Centre, held at Sight Airedale on the first and third Thursdays of the month, gives Paula support from others with sight loss. Having someone say, "I get that too," really helps.

Keema Shepherd's Pie

by Martin Lingard

Just before Christmas, I met a friend for lunch in Leeds.

I ordered a shepherd's pie made with lamb keema curry, with lentils mashed into the potato topping. It was absolutely delicious. This is my attempt at recreating it, and I hope you enjoy it as much as I do.

I like to serve it with a homemade tomato sauce, but gravy works just as well. It's filling, comforting, and wonderfully warming on a cold winter's evening.

Ingredients (serves 4)

For the filling

3 tablespoons sunflower oil
1 medium onion, peeled and chopped
6 garlic cloves, peeled and finely chopped
1 thumb-length piece of fresh ginger, peeled and grated

1 green chilli, finely chopped
1 teaspoon ground cumin
1 teaspoon ground coriander
1/4 teaspoon chilli powder

750g minced lamb
300ml water

300g frozen peas

1 teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons lemon juice

1 teaspoon garam masala

For the mash topping

200g red split lentils, rinsed
500ml water

2 slices of fresh ginger, about the thickness of a £1 coin
1/2 teaspoon ground turmeric
750g floury potatoes, peeled and cut into large chunks
75g butter, and Salt, to taste

Method

Start with the filling. Heat the oil in a large frying or sauté pan and add the onion. Fry, stirring often, until it begins to colour, then add the garlic. Stir for a minute or two before adding the grated ginger, green chilli, cumin, coriander, and chilli powder.

Give everything a quick stir, then add the lamb. Fry, stirring frequently, until browned, then pour in the water. Bring to a gentle simmer, reduce the heat to its lowest setting, cover, and cook slowly for 30 minutes. Add the peas, lemon juice, and garam masala. Cook uncovered until almost all the liquid has evaporated and the peas are tender. Turn off the heat and set aside. Next, put the lentils into a saucepan, cover with the water, and bring to a simmer, skimming off any scum that rises to the surface. Add the sliced ginger and turmeric, then simmer gently, uncovered, for 20–30 minutes, stirring occasionally, until the lentils are fully cooked. You're aiming for a thick, porridge-like consistency. Once cooked, remove and discard the ginger slices.

While the lentils are cooking, bring a large pan of salted water to the boil and add the potatoes. Boil for around 20 minutes, until tender, then drain and mash well with the butter. Stir in the lentil mixture, mix thoroughly, and season to taste with salt. Finally, preheat the oven to 180°C.

Assemble the pie as you would a traditional cottage pie: spoon the lamb filling into a suitably sized ovenproof dish, top with the potato and lentil mash, and level using the back of a fork. Bake for 20–30 minutes, until the topping is golden and lightly crisped.






