

CHEAP TRAIN FARES FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS on KWVR

Since the line re-opened in 1968 the KWVR has very much been part of the local community, although primarily a tourist railway for visitors to the area. For many years however, the KWVR has operated a scheme whereby those people who live local to the railway can get a discount on the price of their tickets – thereby really becoming a community railway.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A RESIDENTS' RAILCARD?

If you live in the postcode areas BD20, BD21 or BD22, then yes – you can get a Railcard.

A Railcard is valid for one adult – the one whose name and photo appears on it. Each Adult can take with them up to 3 children aged 5 to 15 inclusive at around half the local resident adult fare. We also offer extra discounts for Senior Citizens and Children, more details on these further down the page.

HOW DO I GET A RAILCARD?

To get a Railcard you firstly need a passport sized photo. Then you simply go down to your nearest KWVR station, present your completed application form (available to download on kwvr.co.uk), provide proof of postcode, and we will issue your railcard. Proof of postcode must be a something recent which shows your name and address. For example driving licence, recent utility bill etc. Child and Senior Railcard applicants will also need to bring proof of age.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

A Railcard costs £5, and is valid for 1 year. You could save more than the cost of the Railcard in one journey!

WHAT SAVINGS DO I MAKE?

All Local Residents receive 50% discount on the standard fare. This includes Adult, Senior and Child fares.

The Railcard gives discounts on almost every day we run, however, they cannot be used on Santa Special Trains (they can be used on the diesel service which operates on the same day as Santa trains, but not on the Santa trains themselves), or on certain special trains such as dining trains. On almost all other Special Event days they can be used, however the level of discount may be altered on some special events. If in any doubt, please check the web page for the event, or give us a call.

Brontë Parsonage Museum at 90

A History of the Museum in 10 Objects



Working as a Museum Assistant at the Brontë Parsonage is a dream job and a privilege. Meeting visitors from all over the world is a wonderful experience and I enjoy people's reactions to the parsonage and its incredible treasures. The house is graced with items that the family used on a day-to-day basis and I get asked many questions. People are always astounded by the fact that so many of the family's personal possessions have made their way back home.

One of the most significant sources of provenance for the treasures is a sale which took place after Mr Patrick Brontë died in 1861. Mr Nicholls, Charlotte's husband, had stayed at the Parsonage after Charlotte's death in 1855 in order to help Mr Brontë. After Mr Brontë died, Mr Nicholls inherited many of the Brontë family's possessions. He returned to Ireland, his birthplace, and took with him the items he wished to keep. The remaining household items were placed in

an auction which took place on 1st and 2nd October 1861.

Candlesticks, tea pots, kitchen scales and furniture were among many general household wares which were included in the sale. Although Charlotte was quite well-known at the time of her death, many people who attended the auction did so in the hope of obtaining a bargain!

A well-known item in the sale was the dining table at which the sisters wrote. It is considered to be one of the most important literary artefacts of the nineteenth century. The use

of the dining table as a writers' table is evidenced by the number of ink blots on it and you can tell it has been well-used. It is precisely because of the detailed inventory of the lots sold at the 1861 auction that the provenance of this, and many of the other treasures in the possession of the Brontë Society, can be confirmed.

As well as being a valuable source of provenance, the sale catalogue is an incredible source of information about the daily life of the Brontë family. Included in the auction were fascinating items such as silk umbrellas, a coffee mill and a pestle and mortar. There were also many books listed, including grammar books and a History of Rome.

Being the complete Bronte enthusiast I am, I am so happy to work with these treasures used by the family. It is also exciting to know that Brontë household items, which were sold in that 1861 sale, are still finding their way back to Haworth.

Pasta with 5-veg sauce



Being born and bred in Yorkshire means me and my siblings had two choices at dinner: take it or leave it. An approach I've tried (with far less success) on my own children. Whilst me and my sisters would resign ourselves to eating whatever 'problematic' meal mum had served (corn-beef hash and steak and kidney pie were the most contested), my children cheerfully declare that they'll 'leave it' before skipping off to continue whatever havoc they were wreaking before my failed attempt at dinner.

Their list of 'problem' foods consists of anything a bit slimy in texture - onions, mushrooms, aubergines, courgettes, tomatoes, sweet potatoes – which is ironic considering how much they love making slime! My 8-year old still gags whenever she eats a tomato, and mushrooms will forever be 'bingusting' to my youngest no matter how small I chop them.

So, this recipe is for all the mums and dads who want to serve up a healthy, nutrient-packed meal without the inevitable showdown.

Ingredients

2 carrots (roughly chopped)

2 onions (roughly chopped)

2 celery sticks (roughly chopped)

10-15 cherry tomatoes (5 normal tomatoes)

2 cloves of garlic (crushed)

I pack of Quorn mince

3 tbsp olive oil

150ml/1/4 pint veggie stock

I x 400g chopped tomatoes

2 tbsp of sundried-tomato pesto

Pinch of table salt

Pasta of choice

Method:

- 1. Heat a large frying pan until hot and add half the oil. Cook the Quorn mince until for 4-5 mins. Remove from the heat and transfer to a plate.
- **2.** For the 5 Veg sauce, add the rest of the oil, the onions, carrots, celery, cherry tomatoes, garlic and a good pinch of salt to the pan and cook until softened (about 5-6 mins). Add the stock, tinned tomatoes and bring to the boil. Keep stirring.
- **3.** Remove from the heat, add the pesto, allow to cool slightly then blitz in a food processor until completely smooth.
- **4.** Return the 5 veg sauce and mince to the pan (not on the heat) and combine.
- **5.** Meanwhile cook yours (or your kids'!) pasta of choice as instructed on the packet. Once cooked, drain and toss in a little olive oil or vegan spread/butter to stop it sticking together.
- **6.** Then serve and sit back, safe in the knowledge that there are no 'bits' in it.

Aireworth Dogs in Need



We are often asked "how does it all work?" below is how **Aireworth Dogs in Need** operates in a nutshell!

We are all volunteers – Aireworth Dogs In Need (ADIN) has no paid staff and everyone involved has other commitments; work, family etc and rescue activity is squeezed in amongst our "real lives"!

Daily we are asked for advice or to rehome peoples dogs; usually health, relationship, work or housing related reasons are presented. Often it's an emergency from people at crisis point wanting the dog moving that week or even that day.

About 65% of dogs we rehome come to us from owners, the remainder being requests from the pound. Unclaimed dogs are on "put to sleep lists". The pounds contact rescues like ADIN to request we take the dog to prevent them being euthanised.

We're a foster-based rescue; we don't have kennels or a "centre" so without free fosters we can't help. This is our biggest

challenge; we rely on fosterers and when dogs are coming from the pound we don't know the history so need pet and childfree options whilst we assess the situation. Our fosterers are so valuable; they allow dogs to come in, settle into a home environment to be assessed before we can match them to the perfect home. We hate saying no to any dog in need, exploring every option to get them safe, often involving numerous phone calls and iuaaling to find a suitable space. Once a dog arrives in our care, we take it to the vets for a health check. Very few are vaccinated or neutered so we undertake this asan.

Unsurprisingly some dogs have behaviour needs due to past experiences. It's sad and challenging to see dogs scared and unsure and sometimes this presents as aggression. Working with qualified behaviourists we assess the dog, offering support to the fosterer so they can help the dog feel safe and secure.

We home-check every person wanting to adopt or foster with us so we know the sort of home they can offer. Again this is all done by volunteers and approved by our committee.

In 2017 we rehomed 112 dogs and so far this year 74 have gone into forever homes; all in our spare time! If you would like to donate or become involved in ADIN please contact us:
